# The Original Okeechobee MudFest Park Rules

## You must have State Issued Photo ID with you to enter the park!

**CASH ONLY** at the gate.

Two things are required for ALL side by sides and ATV's:

- a safety flag,
- and either lights or a glow whip at night!

\*\* MUDDING AREAS ARE FOR MUDDING, GRASSY CAMPING AREAS ARE FOR CAMPING – GET CAUGHT MUDDING IN A CAMPING AREA AND YOU WILL BE ESCORTED FROM THE PARK \*\*

\*\*ONCE GATES ARE CLOSED, DO NOT PASS THROUGH THEM. DOING SO WILL
RESULT IN A FINE AND YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE PARK\*\*

PLEASE NOTE - you may NOT save camping spaces for others. All caution tape WILL be removed from your campsite.

All riders under the age of 18 must have both parents or both legal guardians sign the minor's consent form and be supervised by their parent or adult guardian at all times. See Waivers tab for details.

Everyone entering the park must sign liability waiver regardless of whether they are riding or accompanying a rider.

#### \*\*Riding in the bed of a truck is not recommended\*\*

No sitting on the sides of truck beds, door windows, or standing in sunroofs.

Wristbands must be worn throughout the entire stay at the park. Anyone found without a wristband will be asked to leave the premises immediately and be forced to pay the entrance fee to re-enter.

# All riding is at your own risk.

All riders must obey the directions of Okeechobee MudFest personnel at all times.

Anyone refusing to obey the staff will be removed from the park.

\*\*ZERO TOLERANCE FOR FIGHTING – Fighting will ensure your removal from the park.\*\*

\*\*All driving will stop at dark. This will be strictly enforced.

Quiet time is between midnight and 7am. Please return to camp, get some rest, and prepare for the next day.

\*\*No personal light towers or floodlights.\*\*

\*\*No stripper poles allowed\*\*

Three Wheelers and Motorcycles are not permitted.

### All riders must obey posted speed limits.

All manufacturers safety recommendations must be followed. Safety Equipment is strongly recommended for all riders. Riders 16 and under must wear a helmet.

All vehicles must remain within the boundaries of the park and avoid all restricted areas.

Please leave wildlife alone.

Campfires must be kept in designated camping areas and must be attended at all times.

Burning of pallets or tires is not allowed.

No Glass Bottles or Containers are permitted.

No Underage Drinking. All state alcohol laws apply.
