

COVID-19 Phase 3 update

As of Friday July 17th at 12:01 am, we are thrilled to announce that some normality will return to Cedar Cove Resort. We know that this summer has been difficult, and we are not out of the woods yet, but this is a huge step forward.

- Playgrounds will reopen
- Starting July 23rd the pool will be lifeguarded 5 days per week allowing a maximum of 15 people in the pool enclosure. The pool washrooms will be open while the pool is open (10:00 am-8:00 pm daily). Adult swim will be brought back from 12:00pm-1:00pm, and from 7:00pm-8:00pm daily. During adult swim the pool will not be guarded and the 10-bather restriction is in place.
 - The beach toys are back! please remember to use with caution.
- The Lakeside Grill will open for dine in and patio service by reservation only with time allowance of 90 minutes per table. Please remember that you are to physically distance while in the grill or on the patio, and are not to mingle with other tables. Tables dining together should be kept to people in the same family unit or "bubble". Dogs will not be permitted on the patio at this time. Please note when making patio reservations, that we will not have a spot available inside if bad weather should occur so please check the forecast prior to making patio reservations.
Reservations will be staggered in time to accommodate effective service.
- The Washhouse laundry facility will re-open. Please respect your fellow campers and staff when using the laundry facility. Try to use only the time necessary to do your laundry and wait outside between loads to allow others to tend to their laundry while still physically distancing. Masks must be worn inside the washhouse as well.
- Please remember that face coverings are now mandatory in all indoor areas accessed by the public in our township. This includes The Lakeside Grill. For more information please visit Leeds Lanark and Grenville health unit website.

Please remember that with these restrictions lightening, we are still asked to keep our groups to 10 people and to still physically distance from others. We are so thrilled that we are able to return to a different version of normal, and know that with your cooperation, we can keep these much-missed luxuries, and continue to move forward.
