Gaming News

Poker Has New Champ

Damian Salas of Argentina defeated the USA's Joseph Herbert heads up to win the 2020 World Series of Poker Main Event in Las Vegas this winter. The 46-year-old amateur player turned \$300 into \$2.55 million after qualifying for the event via an online satellite tournament. A grueling six-hour heads-up match at the Rio All-Suites Casino that began as a war of attrition ended in fireworks. Salas had clawed his way back after facing an 8:1 chip deficit. Now, on hand #172 with the blinds forcing the action, the Argentine called his opponent's jam all-in, only to see his K-J needed help against Herbert's A-Q. Help duly arrived in the form of a king on the turn and river—cruelty for the American, and rapture for Salas, a 46-year-old Argentine who has cashed 31 times in WSOP events since 2009 and has gross lifetime live tournament earnings of \$5.2 million. “Going into the championship, I felt all the energy and support from my family and friends in Argentina tonight, and that helped me,” Salas told reporters after his big win.

New Jersey Online Operators Face Penalties

Some online gaming operators in New Jersey have engaged in the practice of trying to prevent players from withdrawing their funds. The state's top gaming regulator says such marketing schemes must stop. There are nearly two dozen mobile sportsbooks operating in New Jersey, one being FanDuel. The internet sports betting platform is partnered with the Meadowlands Racetrack. In a recent advisory bulletin, David Rebuck, director of the New Jersey Division of Gaming Enforcement (DGE), says gaming operators must facilitate withdrawal requests without interference. He says that while the law does not specify a certain time frame that an internet gaming withdrawal must be processed, “The rules do not

countenance unnecessary delay.” He went on to state that operators should clearly understand that the Division will take regulatory action and impose civil penalties whenever patrons are improperly encouraged or incentivized to rescind their withdrawal requests for the purpose of resuming gaming activity.” New Jersey is one of only three states that has online slots and table games, interactive poker, and mobile sports betting. Pennsylvania and West Virginia are the other two. There are currently 33 licensed online casino sites live in the Garden State. There are another 21 licensed mobile sportsbooks in operation. That number will soon expand to 22 when PlayUp takes its first wager via the internet. The sportsbook platform is licensed in the state through its partnership with the Freehold Raceway.

Indiana Mayor Comes Clean

The former mayor of Whiting, Indiana, recently told a court that he did have a gambling problem. He escaped a prison sentence for plundering his campaign funds for money to blow in casinos. Joseph Stahura resigned after 16 years as mayor of the city in Lake County in the Chicago metropolitan area last August. A month later, he pleaded guilty in a federal court in Hammond to charges tied to the misuse of around \$255,000 since 2014. Stahura, 68, and his wife, Diane, 64, spent the money on trips to mostly out-of-state casinos. They also used it to pay off credit cards, income tax, and medical bills, according to court filings. According to The Chicago Tribune, prosecutors pushed for a custodial sentence for the former mayor. “Stahura's conduct was wrong and illegal, but it didn't impact his role as mayor, and I think that's an important distinction,” said Stahura's lawyer, Kerry Connor. The judge also noted the defendant's contrition and the fact that he had paid most of the money back. Stahura apologized to the court for his conduct, saying he deeply regretted his actions.

How to Find Affordable Housing for Seniors

Dear Savvy Senior,
Are there any resources to help seniors find and pay for senior apartments? My aunt, who's 75 years old, needs to find a new place to live but has very little money. What can you tell me? — **Searching Sarah**

Dear Sarah,
Finding affordable senior housing options can be difficult depending on where your aunt lives. Senior apartments for some retirees are a good option, and you'll be happy to know that there are a number of government programs that can help out financially. Here are some tips that can help you and your aunt find a low-income senior apartment that fits her budget and living preferences.

Start with HUD

There are several different government programs available today that can help individuals who qualify to locate and pay for housing, including:

- **Housing Choice Voucher Program (Section 8):** This program allows you to find the housing you want. The government provides the amount allowed by your voucher to the landlord each month. Privately



owned subsidized housing: HUD helps some apartment owners offer reduced rents to low-income tenants.

- **Public Housing:** These communities are generally apartment buildings or complexes that are overseen by a city or county public housing agency, and are available to low-income families, the elderly and those with disabilities.
- **Low-Income Housing Tax Credit:** This program provides housing to low-income families and includes rents that don't exceed a fixed amount.
- **Section 202 Supportive Housing for the Elderly:** This initiative helps seniors and the disabled. It offers housing for individuals who are able to live mostly on their own but need assistance with certain daily tasks like cleaning and cooking.

For more information about these programs and to locate

apartments in your aunt's area that may offer them, visit the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development rental assistance page at [HUD.gov/topics/rental-assistance](https://www.hud.gov/topics/rental-assistance).

You can also search for low-income housing at senior living sites like [After55.com](https://www.After55.com) and [SeniorHousingNet.com](https://www.SeniorHousingNet.com).

If you or your aunt don't have internet access or have troubling maneuvering the internet, you can also locate nearby affordable housing options by calling your local housing authority – call 800-955-2232 to get your local number. If your aunt lives in a location that spans multiple counties, check with the housing authority in each one to compare.

How to Choose

If you or your aunt find several apartment choices that fall within her budget, she should consider what's important to her. She may want housing that's close to family, religious organizations,

senior centers, or places she visits regularly, like grocery stores, parks or gyms.

Or, if she has a disabling condition, it may be especially critical for her to find a living space that has easy access to important services like senior transportation and health care centers.

In your housing search, you may also come across some red flags that indicate a retirement community wouldn't be a good fit for your aunt. Keep an eye out for extra fees that may be applied to everyday items or perks you normally wouldn't think about like laundry service, parking or pets.

You should also make sure the apartment is in good condition and then scout out the neighborhood. Ask yourself if the community is clean and well maintained and if there is any debris or messy landscaping. If you notice anything out of the ordinary, follow up with questions before your aunt signs a rental contract.

Get the VA Welcome Kit

It doesn't matter if you've been out for years or are just now separating from the service, the Department of Veterans Affairs has a gift for you: the VA Welcome Kit. It's something every veteran needs to have on hand for current information you need now or things that can come up over the years.

It's all about your VA benefits and the services it offers for the veteran, families, survivors and caregivers. Each kit has over a dozen quick-start guides for a wide array of topics, including health services for women, accessing urgent care, mental health services, getting caregiver benefits, home loans, explanation of disability ratings, applying for burial in a VA cemetery and getting educational benefits. They give step-by-step instructions, as well as listing the documents

you'll need, links to specific web pages (put your cursor on one and click), telephone numbers and departments within the VA system.

Getting one of the kits is easy: Just download it (www.va.gov/welcome-kit) as a .PDF file either in black and white or color. If you only want one specific guide, scroll down the page and pick your topic. Further down are links to other topics such as housing assistance, careers, life insurance, pension and more.

I give this kit an A grade. The VA put a lot of thought into it, and it's well done. Take a look. So far there have been over 1 million downloads. Suggestion: Print it out (42 pages) and put it in a folder so it's handy.

As a final note: Are you still doing the full minute hand washing? Never mind the 20 second wash, go for the full minute. Keep your nails short and scrubbed. Wash often. I suspect what you are seeing is all the holiday gifts these players received and are now happily wearing to Bingo. And trust me, this scene is not just playing out

at your Bingo hall, but at halls and casinos throughout North America.

As a writer of a Bingo column and a Bingo player myself, I know that come Christmas I am guaranteed to receive at least one (and usually several) Bingo-related presents. While I am not quite sure why people assume that Bingo players love oversized sweatshirts decorated with giant silk-screened Bingo cards and splattered with sequins and glitter, they certainly seem to. And how can a loving grandparent not wear such a gift from a wide-eyed grandchild, if only to be able to boast to their friends about what wonderful grandchildren they have? —*Aunt Bingo*

Dear Aunt Bingo,

I hear an awful lot of people say that they win more money at Bingo and casino games than they lose. This is kind of hard to believe when you see hundreds of people playing and only of handful of them are winners. Don't you think that a lot of them are just telling fibs? — ***Suspicious in Colorado, via e-mail***

Dear Suspicious,

There are a number of answers to your question. The first is, as you say, these folks are simply not telling the truth, which is, of course, a possibility. But they may be fibbing for one of two reasons: either it is intentional, or they honestly believe they are ahead of the game whether they really are or not. There is also the possibility

that the people who have had a losing year simply keep quiet about it, while the winners can't help but brag—which is why you get the impression that “everyone” is saying they are winners.

Keep in mind, too, there is a LOT of money to be won in Bingo halls and on casino gaming floors. With Bingo alone, if you go once a week, that's 52 weeks of opportunities to win. Go three times a week and that climbs to 156 opportunities. If you play 10 games at each of those 156 outings, that's 1,560 chances. And if you play 10 cards during each of those 10 games at all 156 of those trips to the Bingo hall, that's 15,600 chances to win—not including pull tabs and other Bingo hall extras. —**Aunt Bingo**

With slots, the popular choice for mobile gamers, you will recognize these titles: MegaMoolah, Gonzo's Quest, Goblins Cave, Private Eye, Immortal Romance and Book of Ra. Most mobile casinos allow you to test their games for free.

User Stats and Revenue
Mobile gaming revenue worldwide is about \$63 billion US in 2020. There are about 2.2 billion mobile gamers in the world. This makes up about 28% of the world population.

Mobile Devices
Generally, the recognized types of mobile devices are Apple/iOS products and Android tablets. Apple's smart phone has been a leader in the worldwide mobile market. There is, however, serious competition from Google's Android phones. Ease of use and carry is the big advantage for mobile gamers who want to play and bet.

2) Playtech Mobile Hub offers access for mobile gamers to both casino games and sportsbetting. The company provides the code that powers a huge number of the world's top poker sites. Playtech signed a deal with DC to produce comic-themed games like Blade, Fantastic Four, Captain America, Ghost Rider, Daredevil and Iron Man. Other popular slot titles are King Kong, Bonus Bears and Gladiator.
Playtech's live dealer platform creates an authentic and unique live gaming experience. Play blackjack, baccarat, poker, Hi-Lo and roulette in the language of the country; like UK, Italy, and Spain.
3) Net Entertainment or NetEnt was founded in 1996 and is headquartered in Sweden and boasts over 200 games.
When it comes to bonus features, NetEnt leads the way. They offer free spins, progressive jackpots and shifting wilds. Slot games include Gonzo's Quest, Starburst and Jack Hammer. Poker Talk



Don't Play Into the Hands of a Tight Opponent

Time and time again, I see people play in an overly tight manner, hoping to get paid off whenever they pick up a strong hand. While everyone probably knows to simply fold whenever an extremely tight opponent enters the pot, it seems as if the tight players often find a way to get all in with pocket aces preflop against one of their oblivious opponents.

The easiest way to avoid setup situations against tight players is to simply never give them action.

Suppose a player who appears to be tight raises to 500 out of his 10,000 stack from second position early in a tournament with a small

buy-in. So far, he has only played one hand, which turned out to be pocket kings. Everyone folds to you on the button. With almost your entire playable range other than A-A and K-K, you should call -- not because you're scared of your opponent or his hand, but because you want to play a pot in position against someone who will virtually turn his hand face up postflop.

The flop comes Ks 7d 4c. Your opponent bets 600, and you elect to call.

If your opponent bets again on the turn, unless you have A-K or better, you should fold. If your opponent checks the turn, unless you know he's capable of check-calling with a hand like A-A or A-K, you should bet the turn and the river to try to get him off hands such as Q-Q and 9-9.

This should be your default line of play against weak, tight, straightforward opponents. If you think your opponent would bet most turns and some rivers with Q-Q, or if you think he would never fold Q-Q on a K-x-x board, you should instead hope to flop a strong hand while simply getting out of the way when you fail to make a strong hand.

While this seems easy enough in theory, I constantly see players call the tight player's raise with a hand such as Kd Qd, flop top pair, then call down when the tight player makes sizable bets on the flop, turn and river.

In the hypothetical hand mentioned above, let's say your hole cards are Kd Qd. If your

opponent bets on any turn besides a K or a Q, you have a fairly easy fold. Even though you have top pair, second kicker, you have to realize that when most tight players bet twice, they will usually have a range of exactly A-A, K-K, A-K and possibly sets, making K-Q an easy fold.

It's important to always compare your hand to your opponent's range, not the range you or anyone else would play in a similar situation. As long as you know how your opponent will play in most situations, you will be able to make excellent folds, saving countless chips in the long run.

Just make sure you don't mistake a loose player for a tight player.

In some games the dealers must stand on soft 17, in others they hit. Some games allow the players to surrender and double down after pair splitting, and others do not. There are other rules, some which favor the casino more than the player and vice versa. The point is that not all blackjack games are the same. The number of decks of cards being used and the rules determine how much of an edge the casino has.

The third base player can cause other players to lose if he makes a bad play. True or false.

False. Dumb plays by third base players have just as much chance of "helping" everyone at the table as "hurting" everyone. While dumb plays can and usually do upset the smart players, they have no long-term effect on a player's expected outcome.

Never hit a 12 against a dealer's 2 or 3 upcard because you will invariably draw a 10 or picture card and bust. True or false.

False. If you hit you will win 37% of the time and lose 63%. If you stand because you are afraid to bust you will win 35% of the time and lose 65%. It's much better to win 37% of the hands than 35% of them, therefore, even though a 12 is a lousy hand, you'll win more and lose less in the long run when you hit.

I just lost 5 hands in a row so I'm due to win. True or false.

False. The cards don't care that you lost the previous five hands. The chance of you winning the sixth hand is completely independent of whether you won, lost or tied the previous 5 hands. Do not bet based on the misconception you are due to win.

The object of blackjack is to get as close as possible to 21. True or false.

False. The objective is to beat the dealer by either 1) having your hand total higher than the dealer's hand or 2) not busting or going over 21 when the dealer busts.

You will win 50% of the hands at blackjack. True or false.

False. On average you will win 43%, lose 48% and tie 9%. If you discount ties, you will win on average 47% of your hands and lose 53%.

I can overcome the casino's edge in blackjack by using a progressive betting system. True or false.

False. Progressive betting systems will not alter your long-term expectations in blackjack. What they will do is increase the swings in your fortunes one way or the other compared to flat betting over the short term.

A blackjack game that pays 6 to 5 when a player gets a blackjack (and the dealer doesn't) is a better deal than the traditional 3 to 2 payoff. True or false.

False. Blackjack games that pay 6 to 5 are a rip off. The house edge is about 800% greater than an equivalent game that pays 3 to 2. Stay away from any blackjack game that pays 6 to 5 on blackjacks.

The casino has the edge in blackjack because players go first and if they bust they automatically lose. True or false.

True. That's why basic strategy tells us to stand on small totals and not risk busting when the dealer shows a small card and a higher probability of busting.

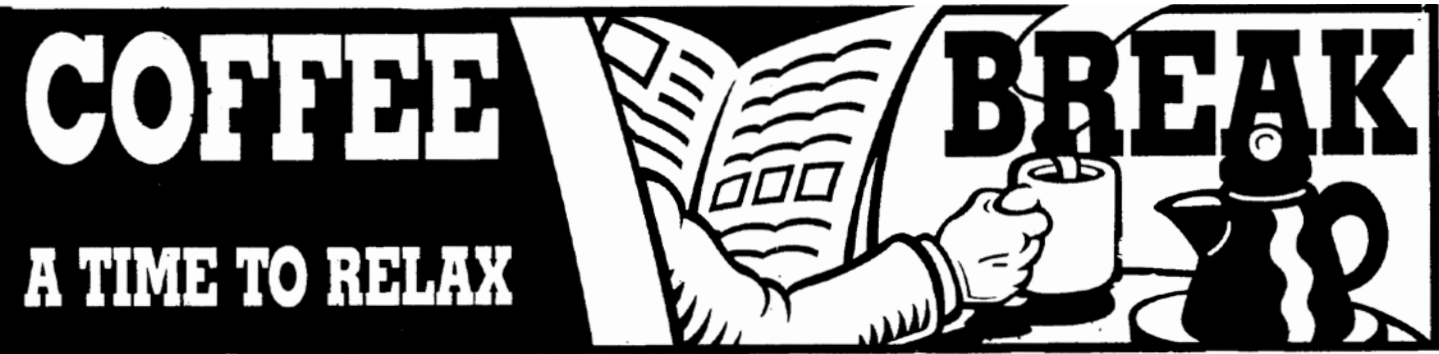
If you had trouble getting the right answers, you may want to invest in a good blackjack book before you risk any money playing the game.
