

## PLANNING PROJECTS

Initial planning and feasibility studies are an important aspect of our work.

These may be initial steps in a larger project or stand-alone studies

- Development of programs quantifying and categorizing space needs

- Evaluation of potential conversion of facilities to childcare or other uses

- Site and building evaluations and comparisons

- Construction type cost analysis

- Special use evaluation
