

### **CONTEST INFORMATION & RULES**

All AMPS categories will be judged using standard AMPS National Contest Rules and Procedures.

- 1. The Armor Modeling and Preservation Society (AMPS) is a non-profit, IRS 501c educational organization that promotes the hobby and art of scale model making.
- 2. This exhibition is hosted by the local Central SC "Wildcats" chapter of AMPS. AMPS Central SC is a SC incorporated non-profit.
- 3. The event is a scale model exhibition for military subjects and figures. The exhibits are judged and scored by a panel of judges according to rules and procedures established by AMPS. Scale model entries are restricted to those subjects satisfying the AMPS rules and other published eligibility criteria.
- 4. The exhibition is open to the general public for viewing. There is no charge for general admission.
- 5. Entries must be registered on the day of the show and satisfy eligibility criteria found at: <a href="www.amps-armor.org">www.amps-armor.org</a>.
- 6. All scale model entries will be judged and scored with the written scores provide to each entrant at the end of the show.

  Membership in AMPS or the Central SC Chapter of AMPS is not required for entry and exhibition.
- 7. Awards are made gold, silver and bronze medals according to the entry scores and the entrant's skill level. Special awards are made for a number of best in category. Show Theme Award Eligibility is listed below.
- 8. Vendors offering scale models and related scale modeling supplies and materials will be on hand. Vendor tables can be reserved by contacting AMPS Central SC. Vendors must reserve table space in advance.

## 50 YEARS LATER: 1967 ARAB-ISRAELI "SIX-DAY WAR" THEME AWARD ELIGILITY

Theme Award Eligibility: AMPS qualifying model subjects from any of the four main combatants – United Arab Republics (UAR aka Egypt), Syria, Jordan or Israel as employed in the theater of operations bounded by those same four countries including their national land areas during the period of 5-10 June, 1967. Subjects must be depicted in the appropriate markings and / or color schemes and with the appropriate time-period technical features to be eligible. Model subjects from other nationalities that were actually present within the above defined area are only eligible if they appropriately depict vehicles or equipment as they would have actually appeared when supplied to one of the four main combatants during the war. Model subjects from other nationalities that were not actually present within this area are not eligible for the theme award even if they are otherwise historically or technically correct for the time period..

Any questions about eligibility will be decided by the Chief Judge whose decision will be final.
