

2021 X-12 Master Schedule:

May 13 THURSDAY

2:00 PM – 11:00 PM – Racers, vendors, and Campers can arrive.

NOTE to campers and racers, NO campfires, period. This is both a landowner and a Box Elder County requirement, due to fire danger. Please don't start one and make us come over and ask you to put it out. Also, X-12 radio returns this year. Tune you car radio to 90.7 FM when you arrive and you can keep current on announcing and everything else that is going on during the busy weekend. You CAN bring a pit bike or 4-wheeler to use to get around, but do NOT ride or drive it like a moron, or you will be asked to leave.

May 14 FRIDAY

7:00 AM – 11:00 PM – Camping area and front gate open to the general public

8:00 AM – 9:00 AM – Hill inspection and final, on-site, late registration for all classes

EXCEPT PROS, which are all done online and close Saturday, May 8 at midnight MST.

10:00AM – 5:00 PM – All altered and semi-pro classes, and pro women and minis compete on 1,200 foot semi-pro and 1,100 foot altered hills.

7:00 PM – Friday Trophy and Semi-Pro Awards

May 15 SATURDAY

7:00 AM – 11:00 PM – Camping area and front gate open to the general public

8:00 AM – 9:00 AM – Hill inspection and final, on-site, late registration for stock classes.

9:00 AM – 4:00 PM – Stock classes compete on the 1,050 foot stock hill, and minis compete on the 750 foot stock mini hill.

9:00 AM – 4:00 PM – 600 Pro class competes on the 1,700 foot pro hill, followed by the 450 pro and 40+ Master Pro.

4:30 PM – 450 Pro side by side, X-Climb on at least a 1,000-foot, TBA hill.

6:00 PM – UTV race on a 2-mile loop, (TBA, three to five laps).

May 16 SUNDAY

8:00 AM – 9:00 AM - Hill inspection

9:00 AM – 700 Pro Class runs on the 1,700-foot pro hill, followed by the Open Pro class
