Missouri Voter ID Law Guide

On June 1, 2017, a new Missouri Voter ID Law went into effect.

But **the new law will not change much for voters.** (RSMO 115.427). Even if you do not have a Missouri state-issued ID, you can still vote!

Here is a step-by-step process to help you exercise your right to vote in Missouri.

### **STEP 1: REGISTER TO VOTE**

You should register to vote right now so you don't forget! You can do this in a few ways:

- 1) Print and mail the voter registration form: <https://www.sos.mo.gov/elections/goVoteMissouri/print>
- 2) Have the form mailed to you: <https://s1.sos.mo.gov/elections/goVoteMissouri/request>
- 3) Go to your County Clerk, DMV, or local government office and do it in person
- 4) Find a voter registration drive near you. [Contact us](#) if you want to organize or find one!

### **STEP 2: VOTE**

On Election Day, go to your polling place: <https://voteroutreach.sos.mo.gov/>

Like before, you will need to bring a form of ID.

#### ***ID TYPE 1*** (RSMO 115.427.1)

- Nonexpired Missouri driver's license
- Nonexpired/nonexpiring Missouri nondriver's license
- United States or Missouri-issued photo-ID with your name on it. If expired, it had to have expired after the last general election
- Nonexpired/nonexpiring military photo ID

#### **IF USE ID TYPE 2** (RSMO 115.427.2-427.3)

You will have to sign a statement and provide your address. Election officials may also take your picture. This is the big difference in the new law.

#### ***ID TYPE 2*** (RSMO 115.427.2(1))

- Missouri state-issued ID
- Local election authority ID
- United States government-issued ID
- Missouri college ID
- Current utility bill
- Bank statement
- Government check
- Paycheck
- Government document with name, address

You do not need a state-issued ID to vote. The same forms of ID you used before will work under the new law.

However, you can get a nondriver's license for free and a supporting document if you want it to vote.

Here's how.

#### **RIGHT TO GET A FREE ID** (RSMO 115.427.6(1))

Under the new law, you have the right to get a nondriver's license for free if you do not have one and want it for voting purposes from a state licensing office: [http://dor.mo.gov/faq/drivers/nondriver\\_license.php](http://dor.mo.gov/faq/drivers/nondriver_license.php)

You will need a supporting document to get one of these IDs. Keep reading!

#### **RIGHT TO GET FREE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TO GET AN ID** (RSMO 115.427.6(2))

You also have the right to get a supporting document for free. These documents include:

- Birth certificate
- Marriage license/certificate
- Divorce decree
- Adoption decree certificate
- Court order of name change
- Social Security card with new name
- Naturalization papers or other US State Department citizenship documents

The Missouri Secretary of State must pay any fees to get these documents, even if the documents are from another state.

Although the law has changed, there won't be much of a change for Missouri voters unless additional laws are passed.
