Mobile Food Application

A Food Establishment that operates for a period of more than 14 consecutive days & is considered a caterer in the transportation of potentially hazardous foods throughout the county. All foods must be from an approved source and maintained in a way that protects the general public health of the citizens of St. Clair County

This applies to all Mobile Food Units that serve Food that is not served from an approved kitchen and inspected by the Health department. The below exceptions are not required to obtain a mobile food permit.

The three exemptions under the Ordinance are as follows:

- 1. A produce stand that offers only whole fresh fruit or vegetables
- 2. A temporary food stand that does not serve Potentially Hazardous Foods
- 3. Any charitable or religious organization must post an exemption placard
