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## About the Estate

The Esterhazy legacy dates back to the 13th century. The estate was designed by Italian architect, Carlone in 1683, and was then occupied by the royal Esterhazy family in 1687. The Esterhazy family was known for the high level of interest in education, art and music but is most notably known for their royal household. The inception of Esterhazy wine began in 1758 when Countess Maria Lunati-Visconti, the spouse of Prince Paul II. Anton Esterházy, gave instructions to plant Pinot Noir vines from Burgundy in Burgenland. The wines were not just adored by Esterhazy family, but also by the world-renowned court musician, JOSEPH HAYDN, who took a portion of his salary in the form of wine. Today, the Esterhazy wines are made in one of the most modern wineries in the world, creating some of the best wines Austria has to offer.
