Due to major unforeseen conflicts involving our scheduled DJ and substitute band, there is an exciting double switcheroo for July! TBDC has changed the theme for the July dance to celebrate the TBDC debut of a popular dance band from Birmingham – 5 of a Kind! Co-sponsored by PARA4Life, the Five-of-a-Kind Dance will be held on Saturday, July 21, 7-10 pm at McAbee Center (3801 Loop Road; Tuscaloosa, 35404). Attire for the evening is dressy casual.

5 of a Kind. Under the direction of Alan Brooks (lab4u@aol.com), 5 of a Kind is a smooth, jazzbased dance band that plays for dance clubs, weddings, anniversaries, parties, and corporate events. Based in Birmingham, this band's members include Kim Bain (saxophone), Chuck King (trumpet), Pearce Cowart (piano), Herb Forsythe (bass), and Mr. Brooks on bass; the sixth member 5 of a Kind is vocalist Kathryn Myrick. Ms. Bain's saxophone work is always a treat; and the band usually includes a danceable "Satchmo" medley of Louis Armstrong tunes that feature Mr. King on vocals with a white handkerchief wrapped around his trumpet. TBDC will invite 5 of a Kind back to Tuscaloosa in 2019, so join us for the July preview.

Line dancing is invited throughout the evening! At McAbee Center, our expanded space can accommodate line-dancers all evening long. Line-dancers should use the dance floor between the tables and snacks; and ballroom dancers should use the space between the tables and the band.

Survey Results
