Lent not only invites us to remember those dry times in our faith journey, it also reminds us of where God has poured streams of mercy over us, quenching our thirst and



cleansing us. In fact, our lectionary readings this week carry us *through water and to water*.

In our Old Testament reading from Exodus ⁹3, even though God has brought some exhausted slaves from Egypt through the waters to freedom, here in the wilderness, they are dry again and complain that God has brought them here to die!

God tells Moses four important things:

Go ahead and take some of the elders with you.

Take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile.

I will be standing there right in front of you on the rock.

Strike the rock and water will come out.

The rock has often been read as a foreshadowing of Jesus, our Living Water, who even though he was struck down, poured out forgiveness and mercy.

When in your dryness, you are tempted to doubt God, hear these words again, "I will be standing there right in front of you on the rock." Remember that when you wonder, "Is the Lord among us or not?"

God is here, calling you forth to fresh streams and new beginnings! Praise God!


