**A. Consider and Discuss Details for Cisco TX PieFest on June 15-16 and Request for Possible Street Closures.—Cindy Underwood**

Mrs. Underwood addressed the Council providing a schedule and map of events and requested the Council grant a closure of Joe Wheatley Circle and E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street on June 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Mayor Pro Tem Weger asked Mr. Diers to verify that the apartment located on E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street be made aware of the street closure and directed the Public Works Director to provide barricades for those streets being closed.

Motion was made by Councilmember C. Johnson to approve the street closures, second was made by Councilmember Forester. Motion prevailed by the following vote:

**B. Consider and Discuss a Variance to the Open Container Ordinance.—Amanda Rogers**

Ms. Rogers requested that the Council grant a variance to the Open Container Ordinance in the downtown area for the Cisco TX PieFest. The Council discussed logistics and time frame for the variance and expressed a desire to prohibit any glass containers. Eventually, the majority of the Council settled on starting at midnight on June 15<sup>th</sup> and ending at midnight on June 17<sup>th</sup> and limiting the zone to 8<sup>th</sup> Street to the railroad tracks and from Railroad Ave. to Ave. E. Councilmember Forester went on record as being against the variance.

Motion was made by Councilmember C. Johnson to grant a variance to the Open Container Ordinance from midnight on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to midnight on June 17, 2018 and from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to the railroad tracks and from Railroad Ave. to Ave. E., second was made by Councilmember W. Johnson. Motion prevailed by the following vote:
