

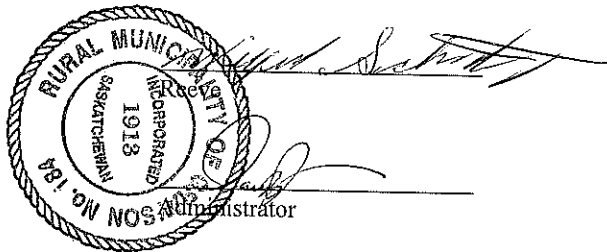

BYLAW 1:2008


A BYLAW TO SET DISCOUNTS FOR PROMPT PAYMENT OF TAXES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of Grayson No. 184 are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31st.
2. Between the months of January 1st and December 31st discounts shall be allowed with respect to the prepayment of:
 - i) the current year's taxes on property;
 - ii) special taxes
 - iii) local improvement special assessments
3. To encourage early payment of the current taxes, a discount shall be allowed.
 - (i) Payments received prior to the 1st day of September, a discount of 5% of the amount paid.
 - (ii) Payments received during the month of September, a discount of 5% of the amount paid.
 - (iii) Payments received during the month of October, a discount of 4% of the amount paid.
 - (iv) Payments received during the month of November, discount of 2% of the amount paid.
 - (v) Payments received during the month of December, a discount of 0% of the amount paid.
4. Bylaw No. 6-2007 is hereby repealed.
