

Cross Lutheran School Tuition 2019-2020

It has been determined that the actual cost of educating a child at Cross Lutheran School amounts to over \$6,300 per student for the school year. As you can see below, the tuition fees we charge are much lower than that. This is possible because of the generous support of the congregation of Cross Lutheran Church and their commitment to providing quality Christian education in this community. Fundraising opportunities exist which will help offset the cost of your tuition with very little effort, and additional tuition assistance is available for those in need of it. A dollar figure should not be the reason your child does not attend Cross Lutheran School.

- Registration fee of \$50 per student is required at the time of registration. This is included in the total tuition cost.
- Tuition assistance is available dependent upon existing funds.

- These rates are for 1st child only. If an older sibling is enrolled in K-8, then the Additional Child rate from above will be applied.
- Half days classes will be held from 7:50 a.m.- 11:15 a.m., Mon.-Thurs/Fri.
- Children must be 5 years old by Dec. 1 to attend.

- Registration/Materials Fee \$35. (This fee does not apply toward tuition)
- Members of Cross Lutheran Church receive a \$10 discount monthly on preschool tuition.
- Tuition payments are due during the first week of each month. Checks are payable to: Cross Lutheran Preschool.
- Classes are held from 12:30 – 3 p.m. Monday – Thursday, Sept. – May.
- Children must be 3 years old by Oct. 1 and be toilet trained to attend.
- Please note that Preschool rates, the number of days offered, and other policies are subject to change, pending the implementation of a daycare.
