TOWN BOARD MEETING 11-8-21

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting of the Town of Eaton was called to order by Chairman Rick Christel at 6:30 p.m., Monday, November 8, 2021 at the Eaton Town Hall. The Pledge Allegiance to the flag was recited by all.

MEETING NOTICES: Meeting notices were posted at the Eaton Town Hall, and the Town Website

ROLL CALL: Rick Christel, Chairman; Adam Schetter, Supervisor, Lewy Schema, Supervisor, Paulette Vogt, Clerk, Pam Schneider, Treasurer, and Craig Zipperer, Road Superintendent were in attendance.

AGENDA: The agenda had been emailed previously. Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the agenda, and Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same, motion carried.

MINUTES: The minutes from the 10-11-21 board meeting had been emailed to the Board previously. Supervisor Schetter made a motion to accept the minutes. Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: A resident had a question about how to get information about building a home on farm land. Chairman Christel gave the information as to the steps it takes to do this. James Downey gave an update on the information he had received from the DNR concerning a culvert on his land. After some discussion, this will be put on the agenda for next month.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT: Road Superintendent Craig Zipperer reported on the many jobs he has been doing this month to also include additional work on Truck 552, grading Marsh and Eaton Roads, and doing some ditching,

SUPERVISOR 1: A comment was made on whether the tile at Lax Chapel and Newton Road was gone. Craig Zipperer will check into this.

SUPERVISOR 2: No report.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer Pam Schneider gave the treasurer's report. \$233,354.88 was the ending balance for October in the bank First Elite Account. She further reported that there is \$40,387.81 in the Bank First Checking Account. The Road Maintenance account has \$25,378.61 balance, the Road Equipment has a \$10,000 balance, the Dog Fund has a \$1,025.56 balance, the State of WI Recovery Grant has a \$43,123.44 balance, and the checking account interest has a balance of \$693.27. A motion was made by Supervisor Schetter to accept the treasurer's report and Supervisor Schema 2nd the same. Motion Carried.

CONSTABLE: No report.

ASSESSOR: No report.

CHAIRMAN REPORT:

SCHNEIDER/ROAD DAMAGE: After some discussion, a motion was made by Chairman Christel that with this particular issue, The Town of Eaton will not allow a non-license person or uninsured contractor to repair the Town of Eaton's roads because of liability. Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion. Motion carried. Mr. Kurt Schneider will get back to the Board on this matter.

COLLINS FIRE DEPARTMENT CONTRACT: Chairman Christel asked Treasurer Pam Schneider to get the information for the mil rate to determine the amount the town will be paying to Collins for their service. This will be put on December's Agenda.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT CONTRACT: After some discussion, the contract will be put on the December's Agenda.

WASTE DISPOSAL MATTER: After some discussion, Chairman Christel made a motion to sign the contract with Harter's Lakeside Disposal starting January 1, 2022. Supervisor Schetter 2nd said motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF VOUCHERS: October Vouchers were paid with a motion from Supervisor Schetter and 2nd from Supervisor Schema in the amount of \$14,503.92. Motion carried.

MEETING REPORTS: The clerk and treasurer attended the County Treasurer's meeting in October. The clerk attended the Clerk's Election Meeting at the County and several people from the Town of Eaton attended the Chief Election Class that Manitowoc County held.

MISCELLANEOUS: A letter was received by Chairman Christel from Bob Radder that will be put on next month's agenda. Also the WTA – Manitowoc Chapter Christmas Party will be held on December 2, 2021 at City Limit's Banquet Hall. Some of our board will be attending.

Supervisor Schema made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same. Motion carried.
