Cabell County Recycling Program Application

Participants in the Cabell County Solid Waste Authority Recycling Program will be granted access to the **CCSWA Recycling Center at 800 Virginia Avenue, Huntington, WV; 7 days a week, 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM**. The recycling center is a secure monitored facility, and may only be accessed with an active pass during the hours of operation. The pass will be active from the date of receipt to September 30, 2018. The pass will be mailed to the applicant upon approval of this completed application and receipt of full payment assessed upon the application date. Participation in the recycling program will need to be renewed each September by application.

CCSWA Recycling Center Rules

1. One pass per household
2. Allowing nonmember access to the recycling center(s) will cause dismissal from the program with no refund
3. Only accepted recyclable materials permitted to be distributed at center - *see list of materials accepted on back
4. NO PLASTIC BAGS (trash bags), Paper bags are acceptable
5. Dumping non-recyclable garbage at the recycling location will cause dismissal from the program with no refund
6. Lost passes may be replaced upon request at a charge of \$10.00
7. Admittance into the recycling center may only take place within the hours of operation, 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM daily

I have read and understand the CCSWA Recycling Center Rules. I understand that I am responsible for my pass and that any violation of the CCSWA Recycling Center Rules will result in my dismissal from the program with no refund.

List of Accepted Items:

- Glass Bottles & Jars (all colors)
- Metal Cans: Aluminum can, steel cans and lids, empty aerosol cans with the lids and tips removed
- Plastic Bottles (empty, crush reattach lid): Bottles and jugs that have a small mouth and wider base, such as milk jugs, soda bottles, laundry detergent bottles, water bottles, shampoo bottles, and contact solution bottles
- Paper: Newspaper, magazines, cardboard, mixed office paper and envelopes, paperboard (cereal boxes), pizza boxes free of food debris and grease, telephone books and catalogs
- Cartons: Food and beverage cartons, such as milk, juice, soup, wine, broth, and other cartons

Recycling Tips:

- Mix all items together – no separation required
- Empty all bottles, jugs, and cans
- No need to remove labels
- For plastic bottles: please empty, crush, and reattach lids
- For cartons: please remove plastic caps and straws
- NEVER place medical sharps or needles in the recycling
