WICOMICO HUNT CLUB COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Directors has approved the following requirements which shall apply to all Hunts, clinics and hunt related activities, during the 2020-21 hunt season. These requirements are subject to change if the virus threat levels improve sufficiently on the Delmarva peninsula. The goal is to keep all participants free from infection.

1. In addition to all other required safety equipment, at all times after arrival and prior to mounting horses, all mounted participants must wear an approved mask covering their nose and face if they are unable to maintain a 6-foot minimum social distance. After mounting, face masks may be removed if desired but must be carried with each rider and social distance is maintained between riders.
2. If a rider dismounts for any reason during a hunt, masks will be worn while unmounted unless they are able to maintain a 6 foot minimum social distance from all other persons, such as when rendering aid to another rider or on coming in contact with other persons.
3. Participants who are following on foot, bicycle, golf cart or other means of conveyance must wear a mask at all times when they are unable to maintain a 6-foot minimum social distance from all other persons.
4. After the hunt or hunt related activity is concluded and participants have returned to their trailers, masks will be worn by any participant who is unable to maintain a 6-foot minimum social distance until they are in your vehicle again.
5. During and after hunting, no sharing of flasks or food. Each participant must bring their own refreshments. Until further notice, communal tailgates are suspended.
6. No guests will be invited or permitted, except for paid clinic attendees using their free October cap.
7. Until further notice there will be no joint meets, away hunts or hosting of other hunts or their members.
