CARRYOVER BUSINESS:

A. Zoning Ordinance Amendment-Medical Marijuana Dispensaries

Discussion was held with Attorney Gary Howell regarding options for Zoning Amendment for Medical Marijuana & setting a date for a Public Hearing.

MOTION by Franz supported by Batzer to set a Public Hearing on Tuesday, September 21, 2010 at 7:00 pm at the Dryden High School multi-purpose room for the Medical Marijuana Zoning Amendment which would prohibit medical marijuana dispensaries in any office building, commercial building, industrial building, apartment building, or residential apartment within the Village. Legal medical marijuana caregivers serving up to five legal patients would be allowed in single family residences with no more than one caregiver per residence.

Committee voiced all ayes, Motion carried 7 - 0.

MOTION by Betcher supported by Reynolds to change the time of the next regularly schedule DDA meeting to Tuesday, September 21, 2010 at 6 pm at the location secured for the Public Hearing.

Committee voiced all ayes, Motion carried 7 - 0.

MOTION by Thiemkey supported by Franz to set the following "Rules for the Public Hearing – Public Comment Time"

1. Public must sign in ahead of time to speak with name & address.
2. 3 minute time limited for speaking.
3. Rebuttal time 1 minute.
4. No sharing of minutes.

Committee voiced all ayes, Motion carried 7 - 0.
