2nd Annual One Hot Christmas Chili Cook-off



- Held on the Saturday of the Solomon's Christmas Walk during show at the school (December 8)
- Goal is for 10 to 12 Entries – 2 pots each
- Requires Free Temporary Food Service Permit
 - Health Department Inspection occurs the day of for final sign off
 - Not as scary as it sounds – many lessons learned from last year
- Major Cooking Rules:
 - Each contestant is responsible for supplying cooking apparatus and cooking utensils, as well as coolers and thermometers for food storage and prep
 - No ingredients may be pre-cooked in any way prior to the event. The only exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, tomato sauce, pepper sauce, beverages, broth, etc. MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED, in any manner.
- Chili Cook-off Committee will be formed early October to start planning
 - Decorations
 - Judging/Awards
 - Coordination, etc
