February 15, 2024 Meeting with FCP Tribal Council

Call to order 1 PM

Attendance: Jason Headson, Lynne Black, Ryan Wilson, Diane Dubey, James Crawford, Todd Mulvey and Nathan Gildan.

MOU Winter Maintenance – TM stated to give the County a heads-up regarding gravel roads on tribal lands if assistance is needed.

Indian Highway Safety Program/2025 Road Construction Plan – TM stated they received grant for Highway Safety Specialist position who is working with the Sheriff's Department for a new grant application for enforcement hours. Hours would be used to address uptick in traffic on Town roads due to Hwy 8 closures. JH stated that the state is working on passing a bill to allow towns to drop the speed limits by 20 mph and allow them to be enforceable otherwise the Town would establish an ordinance to take speed limit to 45 mph. TM suggested reduced speed limits for Potawatomi Trail, Indian Drive, Bear Rd. and Otter Creek. He added that an application was put in for a safety fund grant through the tribal transportation program to apply center lines, curb lines and edge lines for Potawatomi Trail. JH stated they will reapply for a grant to purchase speed humps with speed limit signs and barricades. TM stated that maybe the County could utilize their speed humps for problem areas. MOU will need to be adjusted to reflect such.

Update of Rescue Contract - JH discussed changes to the Crandon Rescue contract. He stated the contract price is lower but now includes a \$450 intercept fee. Due to HIPPA laws, the Town/Tribe would not know if transports are from the Town or from Stone Lake. He added that the Town will look into the contract prior to next year.

Road Transfers - TM stated Executive Council will look over.

Thriving Communities Program - JH discussed establishing a walking path from Lake Lucerne to Hwy 8 on Hwy W. He added that assistance would be needed for grant writing. TM suggested the Town apply for a Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant for a feasibility study to be done which would help to determine how much money would be needed for the project. He also suggested have a comprehensive plan done as well.
