We call for papers that address material objects of our period and matters material either literally or figuratively—found in literature, music, sculpture, painting, home arts, exploration, scientific experimentation, or in other arenas—not only in American and British settings but in international settings as well. We interpret "material" in the largest sense, that is, the materials required, and that matter, for any endeavor of our period. And, of course, if your idea does not fit the conference theme, feel free to submit a proposal detailing it, and we will find a place for it if accepted.
