This year our students brought in **1,845**. That is awesome! It brought us great joy to give back to the men and women who have served our Country—We were able to put the Gospel into action.

What an exciting time it is to attend Sacred Heart School! We are experiencing firsthand the importance of connecting with the universal Church, as well as demonstrating the life skills of compassion and caring by helping others in need. We are making a difference in our community!

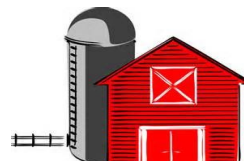

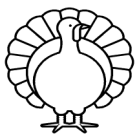
