### Cascade Public Library Expansion Proposal


The Expansion Committee has finished with their planning meetings.

A code infringement must be witnessed by the code enforcement officer (Sheriff's Deputy) in order to issue a citation. OR the citizen raising the complaint will be asked to sign the citation.
