## Good morning!

Double fouls.....what is the resumption of play procedure? Right! Point of interruption! So WHAT does that mean...point of interruption? So here is the easy version....report the two fouls (both go to the team total no matter if personal OR technical fouls – make sure to tell the table in both cases) then go back and resume the game as if the fouls did not happen!

Take a look at the double T after a made goal with an 'and one' as the reporting official is going to the table...it is <u>here</u>.

Obviously they should have kept the players on the lane lines and played off the result of the free throw as we normally would have.

The crew did several parts very well – first they got the double T! They did not allow unsporting behaviors between opponents. Second, they did get together to discuss how to resume play. MAYBE if all three had talked sooner (before clearing the lane), the third may have been able to offer the correct resumption of play. MAKE SURE to send both teams to their benches when all three officials are talking so nothing else can happen.

Double fouls of any sort go to point of interruption – report the fouls and then play on as if the double fouls did not happen.

Tuesday extra: MAKE SURE to contact your partners 2 days ahead of time (or whatever timeframe your assigner requires) to confirm the game mostly and to possibly travel together also!
