<b>Thursday, October 28<sup>th</sup></b>	All project applicants who submitted their project applications to the CoC by the CoC-established deadline will be notified by email whether their project application(s) will be accepted and ranked on the CoC Priority Listing, rejected, or reduced by the CoC  New/Bonus Projects that are selected will begin entering requested data into eSNAPS
