MacLennan, Green, Ledtje, Sowerby Capture New Hampshire State Crowns at Barrington

The Major Waldron SA in Barrington was host to the New Hampshire State Shoot July 20-21. There were 86 gunners present at the two-day tournament.

Douglas MacLennan and John Y. Sowerby tied with 82s on the first day in the doubles title event. It took two shootoff rounds to decide the state champion. They tied again with 19x20 on the first event, and MacLennan was victorious in the second inning. John H. Sowerby, son of the runnerup, was high for non-residents with a 91.

At the end of the first half of the singles championship on Saturday, non-resident Ralph Bevis had scored the only perfect 100. John H. Sowerby and Charles Quella had 99s. MacLennan and John Shuttleworth had 98s to top state gunners.

After Sunday's 16-yard race, Kenneth Green was on top in the 200-bird state race after he coupled his Sunday's 99 with

a 97 from the day before. Trailing by two targets with a 194 was MacLennan. Bevis won Class A with 197, and Bill Lyons was high in B with 193. C winner Dave Gleason scored 192, and Leslie Holbrook nailed down D with 182.

The junior honors went to Philip Wright for his 81x100. Shuttleworth took the veteran's trophy for his 95, and the pro honors went to Ed Ulrich for a 93.

Herman Ledtje topped New Hampshire gunners in the handicap title event on Sunday with a 91. Edward Couture's 89 was good for runnerup. A. M. Webber led out-of-staters with 94, and he also captured the 20- to 21-yard award. A. A. Stefanese topped 18-19 gunners with 85, and Alfred Jackson led the back-yardage shooters with 86.

John Y. Sowerby did take home an ATA championship after losing the doubles shootoff. He scored highest in the state all-around race when he broke 358 of the 400 targets. MacLennan won the Austin-Nichols runnerup trophy for his 356. Aubrey Wornham fired a 366 to lead the non-residents, and Victor Montgomery was second with 363.

The association decided to hold the 1964 state meet at the Major Waldron club. Richard Betz was reelected president of the group. John Y. Sowerby was named vice president and also ATA delegate.
