Dear Kristina,

We were saddened to learn from you that the Mobile District did not receive the necessary funding to start the study of the Top Of Conservation Pool for Weiss Lake. However, we have a formal request.

When Save Weiss Lake met with you in Mobile in January 2016 to lobby for the study, we presented a Plan "B". Essentially, Plan "B" was to maintain the full pool for a month longer in the Fall, and bring it back up a month earlier in the Spring. It just so happens that the Corps implemented Plan "B" in 2016, with the stated reason being because of the Drought Conditions. This action had a very significant effect on our area. The fishing season was longer and the tourism that it spawn had a very positive effect. People used their Lake Property longer, could launch their boats longer, which again helped the Economy of the area.

Therefore, Save Weiss Lake, Anglers Unlimited, Kirk Day Probate Judge/County/Commission Chairman, Thereasa Hulgan, and Cherokee County Chamber Of Commerce formally request that beginning in 2017 the Corps Of Engineers implement Plan"B" on a permanent basis until such time that the Corps can complete the formal study.
