#### NEWS:

<u>Yellow Folders</u>: Every Wednesday, your child will bring home a yellow folder. Please take out and review the papers inside, and send the folder back to school the next day. Completed forms may be returned in the folder.

<u>ADW Family Survey</u>: The Archdiocese of Washington Family Survey is enclosed in yellow folders today. This survey helps determine the amount of funding for additional services our school is eligible to receive. Please complete and return one survey per family. The info in the survey is confidential.

PE Days: Please have your child wear their PE uniform on their class' PE day, starting this week:

- Thursdays: Pre-K, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup> grades
- Fridays: Kindergarten, 1st, 4th, 6th, 7th, & 8th grades

<u>Virtus Training</u>: OLSS is hosting a Virtus Child Protection training class on **Thu, Sep. 22**. If you would like to sign up to attend, please register online through your Virtus account by selecting "Register for Live Training".

<u>School Portraits</u>: Lifetouch will be taking student portraits on **Thu, Sep. 8**. Students should wear appropriate dress clothes to school that day. Lifetouch portrait package order forms are in your child's yellow folder today.

<u>Scantron</u>: Scantron testing monitors students' progress throughout the school year. Baseline testing in Math, Reading, and Religion will take place during the week of **Sep. 19-23** for grades K-8. The information from test results helps formulate lessons to progress forward. Please be sure your child is well rested and has a healthy breakfast on testing days, and avoid scheduling doctor appointments during testing times.

- Aftercare: All required forms must be completed before children may attend Aftercare.
