College Bowl Issues Special Note:

Please be aware that there will be no single bowl issue covering all 39 bowl games. Last week's issue only covered the bowl games played from December 26-29 (14 Bowls). This week's issue (sent Dec. 26) will cover the bowl games played from December 31-January 1 (11 bowls).

Welcome to the 4th bowl edition of Powers' Picks. It is certainly a fun time of year to handicap games as you can find legit value in bowl games as long as you know what to look for. Like always, we don't characterize ourselves as strictly technical or situational handicappers. However, some of the things we look for in handicapping the bowl games are motivation factors. Is one team disappointed to be playing in this bowl (example: USC in the Sun Bowl a couple years ago) or is this team really excited to be playing in the bowl.

You also have to factor in the large schedule disparities in the games involving Power 5 conference teams against Group of 5 teams as many times a 6-6 SU Power 5 conference school is far superior to a 9-3/10-2 SU Group of 5 conference school. However, the Power 5 team played a much tougher schedule which skews their season stats but also gives you value this time of year.

Another thing to factor in when making your bowl selections is the travel distance to the bowl site for each school. While it doesn't necessarily affect the coaches and players so much, it does influence the fans as team's playing closer to home are likely to have the added crowd edge in what is supposed to be a neutral atmosphere.

Finally, you have to pay attention to the coaching situation. Not only are you dealing with interim coaches and a lot of coaching turnover, you also have to analyze how certain coaches do in bowl games. Some coaches are terrific regular season coaches but struggle in the bowl games for whatever reason.

We hope you enjoy this edition of the Powers' Picks and below are some answers to any possible questions you may have regarding this issue as it is different than the regular season editions.

Bowl FAQ's

Why are you not doing one single bowl issue that covers all 39 games?

First, there are double the amount of bowl games as there were in the 1980's/90's and instead of all of them being played in one week (Christmas to New Year's Day), the bowls are spread out over the course of three weeks. Therefore, we're releasing our bowl picks in three separate issues. Those releases will only cover those particular bowl games being played that week (see left). Having later, more up-to-date information should result in more accurate results. We firmly believe you need to have later information in today's day and age!

How do I play your star-rated picks in the bowl issue(s)?

First, we will admit that most of the 1-star plays would not be included in a regular season issue. However, most of you will want action on every single bowl game for a variety of reasons and that is why we put a star-rated pick on every bowl game whether it is the side or the total. If you are someone that only likes to take part in a few games each week, then we would recommend you only play the 3-star and 4-star picks as they are clearly the strongest. If you are someone that likes to play 5-6 games a week, then the 2-stars are certainly worth your while.

Basically a 1-star rating during these bowl issues would be a lean (these have gone 42-31-1 the last 3 years in bowl season so don't just overlook them). A 2-star rating on a bowl is a strong lean while a 3-star or 4-star rating is your typical top star-rated play that you would see weekly in the regular season. Please note that the Powers' Pack selections are in rotation order.

Games in Rotation Order

Monday, December 31st

Military Bowl in Annapolis, MD.

2★ Virginia Tech (+5.5). † Cincinnati 28 Virginia Tech 26. Cincy had one of the biggest turnarounds in CFB this season going from 4-8 SU to 10-2 SU. The Bearcats lean heavily on a rush attack that averaged 238 rush ypg and should take advantage of a VT rush defense that allowed 282 rush ypg in their final 7. Meanwhile, it was a tough year in Blacksburg as the Hokies are trying to avoid their first losing season since 1992. One of our favorite bowl trends is to back 5-6 SU teams that clinched bowl eligibility in their final regular season. Since 2008, those teams have gone 42-21 ATS in the bowl game (excited to be there) including 2-0 this year. That trend fits Virginia Tech here and the last 3 times they entered the bowl game 6-6 (2012, 2015 and 2016), they won all 3. Finally, VT should have the crowd edge here.

Sun Bowl in El Paso, TX

1★ Stanford (-5.5). † Stanford 29 Pittsburgh 23. This is a really tough handicap for us. Both teams have had up and down seasons and it's tough trusting either. Yes, the Panthers have a pair of 1,000-yard rushers in Qadree Ollison and Darrin Hall but they only topped 200 yards passing one time this season and only managed 8 pass yards vs Clemson in the ACC Championship game. Meanwhile, Stanford RB Bryce Love is out for this game but he only managed 739 rushing yards this season (2,118 yards last year) and the Cardinal relied heavily on QB KJ Costello (3,445 passing yards). Looking over Stanford's injury report, we see that the Cardinal will be without WR Trent Irwin, LT Walker Little, RG Nate Herbig, CB Alameen Murphy and DE Dylan Jackson. However, Stanford head coach David Shaw is 4-2-1 ATS in bowls (Pitt's Narduzzi is 0-2) and the Cardinal just played here 2 years ago.

Redbox Bowl in Santa Clara, CA

2★ Michigan St (+2.5). † Michigan St 24 Oregon 23. Both teams had relatively disappointing seasons. Oregon has the clear edge on offense in this one led by QB Justin Herbert (28-8 TD-to-INT ratio) while the Spartans' QB's (Brian Lewerke and Rocky Lombardi) combined for a 11-13 ratio. Michigan St only averaged 20 ppg while Oregon averaged 37 ppg. However, the Spartans have the clear edge on defense allowing just 18 ppg and were No. 1 in the country in rush defense allowing just 81 rushing ypg. Michigan St did play the much tougher schedule as the Ducks non-conference schedule featured Bowling Green, Portland St and San Jose St. Our deciding factor is the coaching edge for Michigan St as head coach Mark Dantonio is on a 5-1 SU/ATS run in bowl games with the only loss coming to Alabama. Meanwhile, Oregon head coach Mario Cristobal who is a great recruiter, isn't necessarily a great game-day coach and had a bad look in last year's bowl game.

Liberty Bowl in Memphis, TN

1★ UNDER 74.5. † Missouri 40 Oklahoma St 32. Two former Big 8/Big 12 rivals meet here for the first time since 2013. If this were a normal regular season game, we'd be passing here. Normally, we'd look towards the big underdog here but how motivated are the Cowboys? They've had an up-and-down season with upset wins over Texas and West Virginia and a near upset over rival Oklahoma. However, they also got blown out by Texas Tech and Kansas St while losing road games to Baylor and TCU as a favorite. Head coach Mike Gundy has led them to their 13th straight bowl (8-4 SU/7-5 ATS) but a couple of their players will be out for this game including RB Justice Hill (930 yards). On the other side, Missouri was really impressive down the stretch with 5 wins in their final 6 games with their only loss coming on the final play vs Kentucky. The Tigers should want to send QB Drew Lock out with a win here in his final game as a 4-year starter but we don't want to lay more than a TD here. We have a slight lean on the UNDER.

Holiday Bowl in San Diego, CA

1★ Northwestern (+7). † Utah 25 Northwestern 20. Both these teams exceeded expectations this season making their respective conference championship games for the first time. Obviously, the Utes are much more familiar with the area as Northwestern is playing their first game in California since 2013 and it's only their 2nd game in the Pacific Time Zone since 2006. Utah head coach Kyle Whittingham is one of the best bowl coaches in the country with a 10-1 SU/8-3 ATS mark. The Utes could get back QB Tyler Huntley for this game as he missed the final 4 games of the season but will be without leading receiver Brittain Covey. On the other side, Northwestern QB Clayton Thorson had an uneven season with just a 15-to-14 TD-to-INT ratio. However, the underdog in Northwestern games was 11-1-1 ATS this season and it's tough laying a TD in what should be a lower scoring game. Also note the Pac-12's 2-14 ATS run in bowl games.

Gator Bowl in Jacksonville, FL

2★ Texas A&M (-7). † Texas A&M 32 NC State 23. Is NC State motivated to be in this bowl game? Their top WR Kelvin Harmon (1,186 yards) and LB Germain Pratt (leading tackler) are sitting this game out. The Wolf Pack are led by QB Ryan Finley who threw for 3,789 yards (68%) with a 24-9 TD-to-INT ratio. On the other side, if we're buying stock right now in CFB programs for the next 5 years and looking for the most bang for our buck, Nebraska would be No. 1 and Texas A&M would be No. 2. The Aggies are much better than their 8-4 record indicates as two of their losses are to No. 1 Alabama and No. 2 Clemson (Aggies covered both games). The offense is led by QB Kellen Mond (23-8 ratio) and RB Trayveon Williams (1,524 rush yards). Both A&M head coach Jimbo Fisher and their DC Mike Elko prepped for NC State last year while at their former jobs (Florida St and Notre Dame). Also remember, the SEC was 7-0 ATS vs the ACC in the regular season this year and A&M played the much tougher schedule.

Tuesday, January 1st

Outback Bowl in Tampa, FL

1★ Iowa (+7). † Mississippi St 24 Iowa 19. The first ever meeting between these two. It's a sneaky-good match-up here as we feel both teams have great upside especially on the defensive side. While Mississippi St QB Nick Fitzgerald ran for 1,018 yards this year (11-0 ratio last 5 games), it was the Bulldog defense that made national headlines this year allowing just 268 total ypg (No. 3 in the country) and only 12 ppg (No. 1!). Iowa's defense wasn't that far behind allowing just 290 ypg (No. 7) and 17 ppg (No. 11). While we think Mississippi St head coach Joe Moorhead is one of the most underrated coaches in the country, the experience edge definitely goes to Iowa HC Kirk Ferentz who is 9-6 ATS in bowl games (this is Moorhead's first bowl game). Similar to the Holiday Bowl, it's tough laying a TD with a low total. We lean with the underdog who is making their 6th appearance in this game in the last 14 years. However, note their TE Noah Fant has decided to skip this bowl.

Citrus Bowl in Orlando, FL

1★ Penn St (-6.5). † Penn St 27 Kentucky 19. This is the final game for Penn St QB Trace McSorley who has started the last 3 years and is the emotional leader of the team. It is noteworthy that is numbers really fell off this season as he threw for 1,285 less yards and 12 fewer TD's than last year while completing just 53.5% (66.5% last year). On the other side, while Kentucky vastly overachieved this season as far as wins and losses go (most wins since 1984), we think the Wildcats are overrated. They currently rank No. 16 in the AP Poll, but we have them No. 36 and they were just 2-5 ATS down the stretch. Kentucky relies heavily on their ground game (run 64% of the time) led by RB Benny Snell (1,305 rush yards). Note that Penn St faced run heavy offenses this year in Pitt, Wisconsin and Maryland and won and covered all 3 of those games while allowing just 6 ppg in the process.

Fiesta Bowl in Glendale, AZ

1★ LSU (-7). † LSU 33 Central Florida 24. UCF has remarkably won 25 games in a row and makes their 2nd straight big bowl appearance (3rd in 6 years). Unlike last year, we do feel LSU will take UCF more seriously than what Auburn did. Keep in mind, UCF also had QB McKenzie Milton in that upset win in the Peach Bowl last year. Unfortunately, Milton suffered a gruesome leg injury in the regular season finale vs USF this year. Backup Darriel Mack came on (348 passing yards) to lead the come-from-behind win over Memphis in the AAC Championship game (out-scored the Tigers 35-3 in the second half). However, having that kind of success vs LSU's defense is a different story even though LSU will be playing without talented CB Greedy Williams who is skipping this game to prepare for the NFL Draft. The Tigers have remarkably won 8 or more games for 19 straight seasons and are trying to avoid back-to-back losses for the first time since 2015. We do think there is a mismatch at the line of scrimmage with LSU's power run game vs a UCF run defense that allowed 290 rushing ypg in their last 5.

Rose Bowl in Pasadena, CA

4★ Ohio St (-6.5). † Ohio St 34 Washington 23. While the Buckeyes had an up-and-down season full of distractions, they still managed another Big Ten Championship. We expect them to go all-out here in the final game for head coach Urban Meyer who is remarkably 11-3 SU/ATS in bowl games. New head coach Ryan Day already served as the interim earlier this season when Ohio St went 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in those games. On the other side, Washington also had an up-and-down season but the Huskies won the Pac-12 and are making their first Rose Bowl appearance since the 2000 season. However, the Huskies have not been able to step up in the big games lately vs Alabama, Penn St and Auburn. They have a great coach in Chris Petersen but are at a massive talent disadvantage here. Washington schematically is built very much like Michigan with a conservative offense that has a really good defense led by their secondary. We all saw what Ohio St did to that vaunted Michigan defense. This is only the 3rd Rose Bowl game in 35 years for Ohio St and we expect their fan base to travel really well here. Finally, Ohio St is 34-17-1 ATS since 2005 when they are laying less than 7 points (or in the underdog role).

Sugar Bowl in New Orleans, LA

2★ Texas (+13). † Georgia 34 Texas 24. These two haven't met since following the 1983 regular season in the Cotton Bowl. What's Georgia's motivation here? The Bulldogs were basically heading to the CFB Playoff when they were leading Alabama by 14 in the second half of the SEC Championship game. However, they blew the game and now face "only" a 9-4 Texas team. Meanwhile, the Longhorns actually overachieved this season getting to the Big 12 Championship game. Texas head coach Tom Herman is on a 23-2 ATS run as an underdog (back to O.C. days at Iowa St) including 12-2 ATS as a head coach. Texas should be plenty excited making their first trip here since the 1995 season. The Horns are led by QB Sam Ehlinger who had a solid 25-to-5 TD-to-INT ratio and also added 13 TD's on the ground. His shoulder should be healthier than what it was down the stretch of the season.

Week 18 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past couple of seasons we have posted computer projected lines at pregame.com. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 155-129-7 (55%) clip the last two years.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping (much to our dismay). **So far this year's plays are 66-46-3.** Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

With 11 games on the schedule, there's only one game this week where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), and that would be **Virginia Tech +5.5 over Cincinnati**. The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

- The last 20 times a Group of 5 (or former Big East) has played in a major bowl, they've gone 14-6 SU despite being an underdog in 17 of those 20 games.
- Urban Meyer is 11-3 SU/ATS in bowl games in his career. Ohio St is a 6.5-point favorite vs Washington.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

N.Y. GIANTS 24 Dallas 16. Last week the Cowboys clinched the NFC East with a misleading 27-20 win over Tampa Bay. Dallas was out-gained 383-232 but benefited from a long fumble-return TD. On the other side, the Giants have not given up on he season yet. They are 5-1-1 ATS in their last 7 games and nearly pulled a big upset over Indianapolis last week before falling in the final minute. Obviously, this game doesn't mean much to Dallas who is locked in to the No. 4 seed in the NFC. We expect them to rest starters and note Dallas isn't a great team when the game's have no meaning (another 0-4 preseason this year).

KANSAS CITY 34 Oakland 20. The Raiders got their emotional win on MNF over Denver that was most likely the final game in the Coliseum. Clearly the Raiders didn't tank on the season as they are 3-3 SU/4-2 ATS in their last 6 games. Meanwhile, we cashed our top play of the week on these pages fading KC last week in their SNF loss to the Seahawks. KC is now 0-5-1 ATS in their last 6 games. A win here and the Chiefs lock up home field in the AFC. Pass.

NEW ORLEANS 24 Carolina 16. New Orleans beat Carolina 12-9 two weeks ago on MNF. After their come-from-behind win over Pittsburgh last Sunday, the Saints have clinched home field in the NFC. Therefore, this game doesn't have much meaning to them. On the other side, Carolina has now lost 7 straight. Last week Taylor Heinicke started in place of the injured Cam Newton and while he was 33 of 53 for 274 yards, he threw 3 costly INT's. Just announced this morning, Carolina has placed Heinicke on IR and they've signed Garrett Gilbert. With the Saints likely resting players, we'll lean UNDER.

NEW ENGLAND 30 N.Y. Jets 16. A win here by New England and the Pats lock up the No. 2 seed in the AFC. The Pats have been much better at home this year (7-0 SU, +13 ppg and +107 ypg) than on the road (3-5 SU, -2 ppg and -43 ypg). Meanwhile, the Jets continue to play hard in the likely final games for head coach Todd Bowles. However, they did blow a 35-20 lead to Green Bay last week which will be tough to overcome. Belichick is 25-0 SU at home when facing QB's under the age of 25.

Philadelphia 24 WASHINGTON 18. The Eagles still could get a Wild Card berth with a win here and a Minnesota loss to Chicago. Nick Foles continued his magic last week with 471 yards and 4 TD's as the Eagles got a FG on the final play to beat Houston. The Eagles did lead that game by 13 in the 4Q and had a 519-371 yard edge. Meanwhile, Washington blew a 4-point 4Q lead at Tennessee on Saturday (our sympathies go out to those of you who had the UNDER). That loss ended their playoff aspirations as they are down to a 3rd string QB (4th if you count Sanchez). A lot of pressure on Philly here. Pass.

2★ GREEN BAY 27 Detroit 16. Clearly, it was important to Aaron Rodgers to end the Packers' long road losing streak. Down 35-20 at the Jets last week, the Packers rallied to win in OT. Rodgers had 474 total yards and 4 TD's. We're guessing he will play here as he has a shot to finish the season 3-1 without HC McCarthy and prove that it was McCarthy's fault for the Packers struggles. Meanwhile, the Lions haven't shown much fight as of late as we cashed on these pages last week in their 27-9 loss at home to Minnesota. Detroit allowed the game's final 27 points as the Vikings had a 340-223 yard edge. The Detroit offense is averaging just 15 ppg in their last 9 games. Packers roll.

HOUSTON 24 Jacksonville 17. Last week we faded the market line move in the Miami/Jacksonville game and couldn't have been more wrong as the Jags played one of their better games of the season in a 17-7 win. Blake Bortles actually came off the bench to save a middling Jags offense (only 2 TD's in 14Q's under Kessler). Meanwhile, the Texans nearly stole a game in Philly last week (rallied from 13 down in 4Q) only to see the Eagles win with a FG on the final play. Houston needs a win here and a New England loss (unlikely) to clinch a bye but also need a win to clinch the AFC South. However, they are banged up.

BALTIMORE 22 Cleveland 17. A win here for Baltimore not only clinches a playoff berth but also the AFC North. Last week the Ravens had their biggest win of the season as they won at the Chargers 22-10. They are now 5-1 SU with Lamar Jackson under center. The Browns meanwhile are also 5-1 SU in their last 6 games and last week's 26-18 win over Cincinnati actually clinched their first non-losing season in AFC North play since the NFL went to the current divisional format in 2002 (last team to do so). A win here and they finish with their first winning record since 2007. Lean UNDER.

TAMPA BAY 27 Atlanta 24. A great "inside-out" handicap that's offering value. Last week Tampa Bay suffered a misleading loss to Dallas as the Bucs had a 383-232 yard edge. TO's have been the main culprit all year at -18 in margin and the key play was a long fumble return TD for Dallas. Meanwhile, Atlanta was out-gained 436-427 in a 14-point win over Carolina last week as they were +2 TO's (Panthers had 4 drives inside Atlanta's 20-yard line end up with either an interception or stopped on downs). We lean with the Bucs.

3★ BUFFALO 23 Miami 16. After last week's disappointing loss at home to Jacksonville, the Dolphins have been eliminated from playoff contention. Miami has now been out-gained in 9 straight games and have been held to under 200 yards in 3 of their last 4. That included a game vs Buffalo last month where the Bills had a 415-175 yard edge but lost as they were -2 in TO's. The early forecast has temps in the upper 20's on Sunday. We don't think that will be a good look for a Miami team with nothing to play for. The Dolphins are 1-8 ATS in Week 17 the last 9 years and just 3-10 SU/ATS in Buffalo the last 13 years.

1★ Indianapolis 25 TENNESSEE 19. "Win and In" spot for the NFL playoffs here and this game has been flexed out to SNF. The Colts have remarkably won 8 of their last 9 games but last week needed a TD in the final minute to beat the Giants. QB Luck has thrown for 4,308 yards and 36 TD's this year. The Titans also needed late game scores to beat the Redskins. More pertinent was yet another injury to QB Marcus Mariota as this current line of Indy -3 is most likely saying Blaine Gabbert will get the start here. If that's the case, give us the Colts. Andrew Luck has never lost to the Titans going 10-0 SU including a blowout win earlier this year.

PITTSBURGH 29 Cincinnati 16. The Steelers could be the most talented team in the NFL but most likely will be sitting at home for the playoffs (need a Baltimore loss to Cleveland and a win here). Last week's loss to New Orleans epitomized their entire season as the Steelers were the better team for most of the game but a couple of bone-headed mistakes were the difference. Meanwhile, Cincinnati fought hard in the final minutes vs Cleveland to get the back door cover. This is most likely Marvin Lewis' final game and the Bengals' have covered 3 straight games despite a bad defense and banged up offense. Lean Cincy.

MINNESOTA 23 Chicago 17. The Bears need a win here and a Rams loss to clinch the No. 2 seed in the NFC. Meanwhile, Minnesota just needs a win to clinch a playoff spot. If they do win, it's likely they play the Bears again next week at Soldier Field. Chicago is 8-1 SU/ATS in their last 9 games but the Vikings have looked dominant the last couple of weeks. If you're looking to back Minnesota here, note the Bears' defense leads the league in take-aways while Minnesota QB Cousins is one of the NFL leaders with 17. Still we lean with Minny who has gone 28-10-3 ATS (74%) at home under head coach Zimmer.

L.A. Chargers 24 DENVER 18. The Chargers really disappointed last week in their 22-10 loss to the Ravens at home. Clearly, they are a better road team (6-1 ATS) than home team (2-6 ATS). They still can clinch the AFC West with a win here and a loss by KC to Oakland (unlikely). On the other side, it looks like it is all over for Denver head coach Vance Joseph as the Broncos have now clinched back-to-back losing seasons for the first time since 1971-72. They looked hapless on MNF vs the Raiders (0-3 SU/ATS last 3) and the Chargers are playing with revenge after losing Denver last month despite a 479-325 yard edge.

SEATTLE 27 Arizona 12. Seattle doesn't need this game as they have already locked up a playoff bid. Meanwhile, it's most likely the final game for Arizona head coach Steve Wilks who only got one year in Arizona but the Cardinals offense ranks last in every major statistical category. A lot of it has to do with a rookie QB and an offensive line that is really banged up. Big mismatch at the line of scrimmage as Seattle is No. 1 in rush offense (159 ypg) while Arizona is dead last in rush defense (allowing 153 rush ypg). Lean Seahawks even if they rest some starters.

L.A. RAMS 28 San Francisco 20. The Rams need a win here to clinch the No. 2 seed in the NFC. They got some of their mojo back in last week's win and cover over the hapless Cardinals. They were led by RB CJ Anderson who filled in for Todd Gurley and ran for 167 yards. Meanwhile, the 49ers couldn't get the cover vs Chicago last week in a hard-fought 14-9 loss. That was coming off the heels of home upsets over Denver and Seattle. The 49ers are much better than their 4-11 record indicates as they are +14 ypg on season but are an NFL-Worst -21 in TO's.

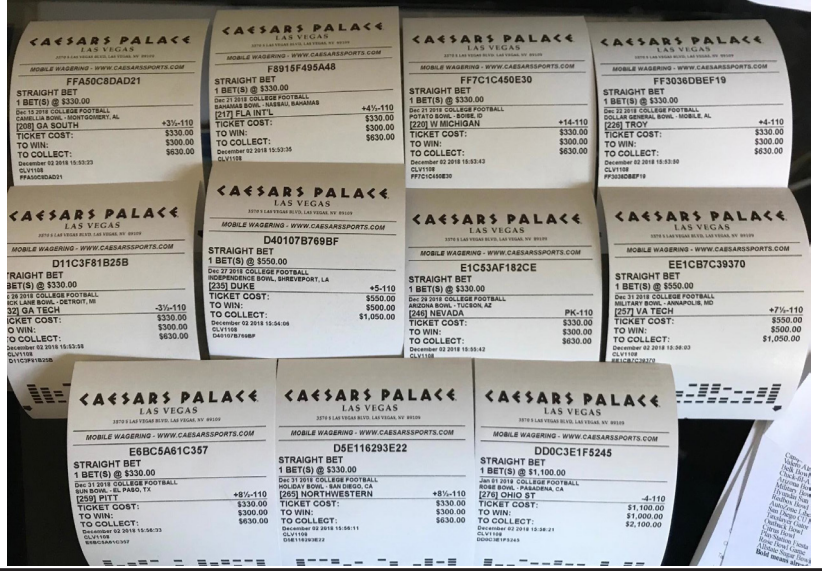
