#### WEEKLY THOUGHTS 31st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME NOVEMBER 3rd 2024

Dear friends, welcome to the celebration of the 31st Sunday in Ordinary time and first Sunday in November. Thank you all for your faith, love and generosity extended to our Church family and other special collections to help our brothers and sisters in need. Thanks so much for your role as good Samaritans.

November 1st is dedicated to All Saints in heaven. These may rank from members of our families. Saints lived the life of Beatitudes. Jesus in his opening Manifesto in Matthew 5: 1-12 called them blessed or happy which is contrary to what the world view of joy and happiness. We are all called to live and embrace the life of the Spirit which is at the heart of the teaching of Jesus.

November 2nd is dedicated to pray for All Souls under purification in purgatory before they enter and attain eternal glory of the Saints. Thank you all who have turned in prayer cards to remember the souls of our loved ones to attain eternal glory.

The Gospel Reading of this Sunday; Mark 12: 28-34 gives us an interaction of the Scribe or teacher of the law.
