I also need to recognize the officers of this post for all that they do. Most of the day to day maintenances problems and repairs are taken care of by a few officers of this post. Without dedicated officers like John Bentley and Don Schoen the post would be hard pressed to keep everything running.

Our post's namesake, Captain Stephen J. Chaney was born in 1946 and graduated from Marion Catholic High School in 1964. The Captain Stephen J. Chaney story reads like a Hollywood script, one starring the likes of John Wayne. However, Steve Chaney was a real person. He grew up in Marion, Ohio and was killed in action on September 23th, 1969, while conducting combat operations in Laos during the Vietnam War. With his unit caught in an ambush after a failed air assault, Captain Chaney despite being critically wounded continued to call in air support while trying to locate all of his men. When medevac help finally did arrive, he was clinging to life but died before the helicopter landed at a field hospital. This brave American soldier was only 23 years old. On, May 3, 2013, in a ceremony at the Ohio State House, Lt Governor Mary Taylor and a host of military officials posthumously inducted Captain Chaney and nineteen other Ohioans into the Ohio Military Hall of Fame. We are very proud and honored to have VFW Post 7201 named after this courageous Green Beret, Army officer.

Captain Chaney is buried in the Marion Catholic Cemetery and the post will be conducting a graveside, sunset memorial service on September 23, 2019, the 50th anniversary of his death.

VFW Post 7201 will always be here to support the veterans of our community as long as local veterans and the post membership are supporting our post. Thank you all for your trust and support.
