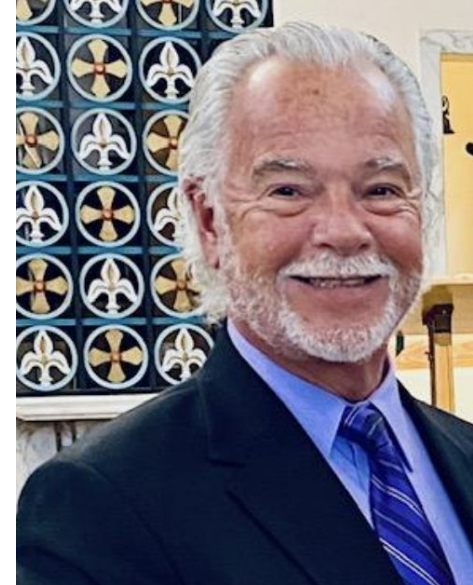

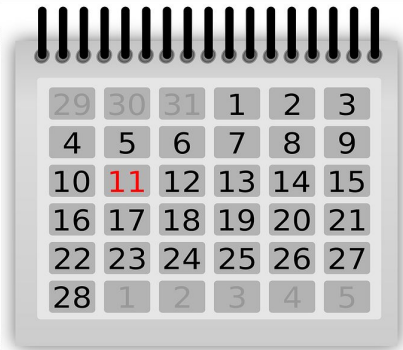
Dear Knights & Columbiettes,

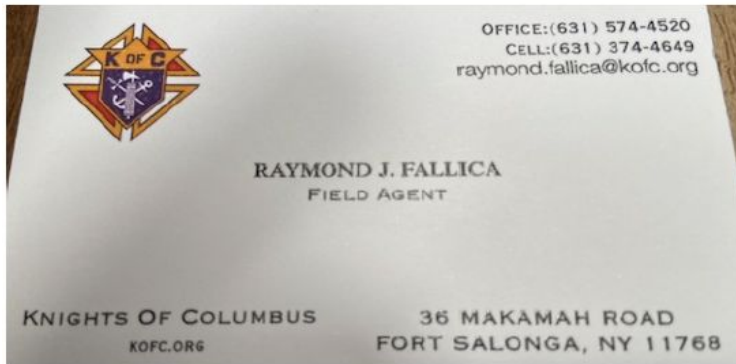
