Job Title & Classification:

Water System Field Operator (Full-Time/Non-Exempt) Eclectic Water & Sewer is looking for a Field Operator.

Summary: The Water System Field Operator works as the primary operator. The operator position works as the on-site hands-on representative, with the ability to quickly and efficiently solve problems and work independently and responsibly. A successful Field Operator has the ability to work under pressure while multi-tasking.

Essential functions and responsibilities: (include but are not limited to)

- Meter reading and customer assistance with water consumption and quality concerns
- Monitors water system by inspection, operation, maintenance and reporting for safe and efficient operation, performs laboratory test procedures, and keeps accurate records.
- Completes turn-on/turn-off orders.
- Conduct sampling and analysis of water systems as required
- Maintain compliance with all State and Federal regulatory requirements and guidelines
- Install new facilities and equipment, repair and replace existing facilities and equipment
- Performs all system maintenance on facilities and equipment as required and able
- Maintains equipment, grounds and buildings.
- Deals with system breakdowns and after-hours emergencies.
- Project management for larger construction projects
- Provide recommendations for improvements to the systems.
- Provides exceptional customer service.

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work:

The field operator position requires weekend, holiday, and flexible shift work which would include pump station and system rounds and emergency repair. Field Operators are required to work rotational on-call hours and frequent overtime is expected.

Physical Demands:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is very active and job requires standing, walking, bending, kneeling, stooping, crouching, crawling and climbing all day.
