

RCMA THANK YOU TEA



Hi - this is Amy. I attended a "Thank You Tea" on January 28th at RCMA (Redlands Christian Migrant Association) at their Avon Park location. RCMA is one of the organizations that we support. It is a child development center for migrant and rural low-income families. They are Florida's largest non-profit provider of early childhood education with 66 centers in 21 counties for 6,500 children. Opening doors to opportunities since 1965. I toured all the different classrooms. Children start as early as five weeks of age and continue until ready to start kindergarten. They even have programs for women to get them medical care during pregnancy and parenting classes which include the fathers. I was very

impressed with their facilities and structure. There was a video of a young man in camo gear who was an alumni of the center and went on to earn an associate's degree in college and pursue his dream of joining the Navy. Very moving. Three year olds came in and sang to us during the presentation and were adorable and made you realize why this is such a big deal. The director noted that the toys we gave to the 88 children in Lake Placid were some of the only gifts some got for Christmas. They loved all the gifts. The doctor kits were extremely popular in helping the children role play going to the doctor and even help relieve anxiety over visits. The diapers, wipes and clothes we send directly impacts these children as well. There are volunteer opportunities at these centers for a variety of roles. Great job LakeSharks!




FIVE O'CLOCK CRUISE III FEBRUARY 29, 2020

RED VELVET CAKE MIX COOKIES

These are easy and delicious.

INGREDIENTS:

1 - 16.5 oz. box red velvet cake mix1/3 c. oil2 large eggs1 c. white chocolate chips

INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350°F. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats and set aside. In a large mixing bowl, add the cake mix, oil, and eggs and mix until fully combined. Add in the white chocolate chips and fold into the dough until well combined. Scoop two tablespoon sized balls of cookie dough onto the prepared baking sheets, making sure to leave a little room between each one.

Bake at 350°F for 10-12 minutes or until the tops of the cookies are set.

Remove from the oven and allow the cookies to cool for 5-10 minutes on the baking sheet and then transfer them to a wire rack to finish cooling. Best when eaten warm.



SLOW COOKER TUSCAN SAUSAGE WHITE BEAN SOUP

Something to warm your innards on cooler nights.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 lb. ground Italian sausage
- 1 medium yellow onion, diced
- 8 c. chicken broth
- 2 large carrots, peeled and cut into 1/2 inch slices
- 3 cans of great northern beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 t. garlic powder
- 1 T. Italian seasoning
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 14.5 oz can petite diced tomatoes

4 large kale leaves, washed and chopped (stems removed) Parmesan cheese, for topping

INSTRUCTIONS:

Heat a pan on your stove over medium high heat. Once hot add in the Italian sausage and break it up. Add in the onion. Stir every minute or so until sausage is browned. Add to the slow cooker. Pour in the broth, carrots, beans, garlic powder, Italian seasoning and bay leaf. Cover and cook on low for 4 hours. Remove the lid. Discard the bay leaf. Stir in the tomatoes and kale. Ladle into bowls and top each with a heaping tablespoon of grated parmesan cheese. Serve with corn bread.



STRAWBERRY LEMONADE JELL-O SHOTS

Perfect for Valentine's Day cheers!

INGREDIENTS:

3 oz. box strawberry Jell-O
1 c. boiling water
1 c. strawberry lemonade flavored vodka, ice cold
Fresh strawberry slices

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Put plastic shot cups on a cookie tray. Place a strawberry slice in each cup and set aside. 2. Pour the Jell-O powder into a medium mixing bowl. Add the boiling water and whisk until the Jell-O is dissolved. Add the ice cold vodka to the hot Jell-O mixture and whisk to combine. 3. Carefully pour the mixture into each cup. Chill for at least 4 hours or until set. ENJOY!
