THE PARK:

The Park shall remain open, until further notice, during normal business hours, to provide service to its members and renters with the following restrictions:

Leaseholders returning to the park and all renters, whether in full-hookup or boondock (retreat) lots are strongly urged to SELF-QUARANTINE for 14 days after arriving in the park.

The Clubhouse doors will remain unlocked but NO SOCIAL FUNCTIONS OR ACTIVITIES will be held.

All members and renters are requested to comply with SOCIAL DISTANCING OF AT LEAST SIX (6) FEET of separation from any person who is not a member of their immediate household.

THE OFFICE:

The OFFICE WILL REMAIN OPEN during normal business hours with the following restrictions:

ALL BUSINESS with the office, IF AT ALL POSSIBLE, SHALL BE DONE BY PHONE. 520-426-3589

When PERSONAL CONTACT with office staff is REQUIRED, ONLY ONE (1) PERSON or family unit at a time may be present IN THE OFFICE LOBBY AREA.

THE MAIL ROOM:
