Read, Read, Read To your children! Use books you have at home. I'm working on a way to get books to you. You can order online at scholasic.com, Amazon...look for books on sale or used, even Walmart and Target. They don't have to be easy readers but some can be. Choose books that are of high interest to your child and read out loud to your child, in any language! (both Fiction and nonfiction. Our class loves books on animal facts!)

Math- use math games to reinforce numeral recognition, addition, graphing, etc. Do you have dice, dominoes, playing cards? These are great for recognition, addition, and homemade games...also Go Fish, War, Double War, Crazy Eights, etc. Simple games and materials are found at the Dollar Tree. Games like Trouble, Shoots and Ladders, Uno, might be in your home. Make homemade BINGO by drawing 5 x 5 cards and simplify by using 1-5 under the B, 6-10 under I, free space and 11-14 under N, 15-19 under G, etc.

On line activities:

Zoo School on Facebook! Live at 10AM but available anytime if you click on it. Learn about animals then follow up with a discussion and make a journal page. Parent can write down the child's sentences about the animal and then the child can illustrate it! Use a spiral notebook or ring binder to keep a collection.
