Greetings from ALA Unit 1879, Colorado State University!

Colorado ALA Unit 1879 envisioned creating an ALA cookbook that would accomplish multiple goals:

- 1. To honor the contributions of ALA members who have for one hundred years given freely of their time and talents in carrying out our mission. Often meetings, outreach, and social events include the quality food for which our members are well known!
- 2. To help bridge the civilian-military gap by including narratives of our veterans and active military. Interviews will be sought from individuals throughout multiple eras of service.
- 3. To bring together members of the American Legion Auxiliary from throughout the nation. We have much in common, despite our geographical distances.
- 4. Anticipated profits will be used throughout the country to support mental health services to veterans. More information will follow.

This special request is coming to your departments because we haven't yet received any vintage ALA cookbooks from your Department, and it's our goal to include every state in the Union in this coffee-table quality cookbook that will celebrate the contributions of ladies of the ALA since our inception in 1919.

The cookbook will be divided into eras as defined by significant military interventions, and as such, we're looking for books from 1919 to present. Ladies of 1879 will identify recipes for inclusion, then we're seeking help from you to be our test kitchens and submit feedback. Original recipe authors will be acknowledged, as will departments and names of those who served as testers. It's our aim to have the book available for distribution at August 2019 Annual Convention in Indianapolis. More information will follow regarding ordering the book.

Professionals will work with us to assess your feedback, then finalize and photograph selected foods. Yum! Resources are listed below to give you more complete information.


