What are we looking for? This leader needs to have a clear testimony of how they became a follower of Christ, and what that means to them. They need to have a good grasp of the Bible and solid Baptist -friendly theology. They need creativity and a reputation for being a hard worker—so you don't have to be looking over their shoulder all the time.



We need someone who has good relationship skills, who relates well to people of all ages—children, teens, young adults, senior adults, etc. This leader needs a good sense of humor and a bit of playfulness.

And it's critically important that our students feel a connection to this person as someone they trust, admire, and enjoy.

So how can we tell all that from an interview? We can't.

So when we find a really good candidate, we bring them in to actually lead an event with our students. Then we can see how well they planned, how flexible they are, how comfortable they are leading our group. We can watch them as they handle off-the-wall questions and the group member who talks too much or doesn't talk at all.



And after the event, our students can answer the question, "Is this someone you would be excited to introduce to your friends?"

On February 20-21, Jon Britton will be with us. Jon grew up in the small town of Rustburg, Virginia. He loves the outdoors, hunting and fishing, and has been a leader at a Christian camp. He is due to get married to a sweet, committed Christian young lady named Mary in May of this year.

We'll have a "meet and greet" time on Saturday night, February 20. And he'll be with us in worship on Sunday, February 21, then he will lead a "mini-retreat" for the students that Sunday afternoon and evening, from 4:00p to 8:00p.

Then we'll pray, seek God's Spirit, and ask, "Is this the one, Lord?"






Luncheon, Tues., March 9 @ 11:30 a.m.




