Today Christians remember the coming of the Magi to visit Jesus, bringing their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. The word "epiphany," means appearance or manifestation.

The arrival of these visitors was a sign that the incarnation of God in Christ had been made known and was recognized by the heavens to the whole world, so that even Gentile wise men from the East came to pay him homage. This is an observance of great majesty, solemnity and awe.

Epiphany originally focused on the nativity, God's incarnation (God made flesh) in the birth of Jesus Christ, and Christ's baptism and later developed as a season of baptismal preparation. Epiphany became associated with baptism. This is why we see images of the three Magi on many older baptismal fonts.


