
A total of 320 man-hours was scheduled; 256 man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions. hours were exhausted on vacation time, workers compensatory, and/or COVID sick leave. 1,683 total miles were driven and the shift responded to 1023 total service calls. The shift issued 12 traffic warnings, 7citations made 1 arrests and handled 20 enforcement service-related calls. The average productivity ratio for this month for this shift is 4.0








