A History of the first Norwegian Immigrants to the USA!

Our very own Fjellheim member, Erik Tjelmeland, pictured left, presented an intriguing history on the **13th April 2022** for the Heritage meeting's cultural segment.

The first Norwegian immigrants to the USA started with 52 individuals who consisted of men, women, children, and one newborn baby all on a tiny "(slooper-class) sail ship called the "Restaurationen". Collectively, these folks were called the "Sloopers" and their valor and quest for freedom spearheaded the trek of 800,000 Norwegian immigrants to the Americas between 1825-1925.

At the **June 8th** Heritage meeting, Erik will continue with **part 2** of the sojourn of the Sloopers and some of those who followed. He will touch on the perils of the Sloopers' journey, their preparations, obstacles, and their success of establishing the first permanent settlement of Norwe-gians in North America. (*p.s. it wasn't in Minnesota*!)

In addition, Erik will shed some light on the following questions:

What happened to the Restaurationen?

What celebrations will be forthcoming in Norway for the bicentennial anniversary of this voyage?

Why is 9 Oct such an important date in Norwegian lore?





DID YOU KNOW? May in Norway has several other holidays in May beside May 17th (**Syttende Mai**) or **Constitution day** their biggest holiday. Here are two more May holidays in Norway

Veterans Day (Norwegian: Veterandagen) in Norway on May 8 was first observed in 2011. It recognizes the efforts of veterans of World War II, United Nations peacekeeping initiatives and other international operations. It was instituted in 2010 by Norway's Cabinet and falls on Victory in Europe Day, May 8.

May Day was first observed in Norway in 1890, and **it has been a public holiday** since 1947. Most shops are closed, schools, businesses and shops are closed on May 1. Only certain small convenient stores and garden centers are open. As **May 1** is springtime in Norway, it is popular to spend this day off outdoors or pottering in the garden.
