2. **Hunter over Fences:** 2'
3. **Hunter over Fences:** 2'3"
4. **Working Hunter:** 2'6"
5. **Hunter Hack** – Jump two 2' fences; then walk, trot, and canter at the judge's discretion.
6. **Knock Down And Out – Prize: \$100 winner takes all!** See description on the reverse side.

7. **Open Showmanship** – All breeds, all disciplines, and all ages.
8. **Tot Leadline** – Children 8 and under. Ribbons to all. No payback. **Fee: \$10.**
9. ***Hunter Equitation*** – Walk, trot, and canter. **Bonus Class! Double Payback!**
10. **Beginner Youth** – All tack – Ages 12 and under. Walk only. **Entrants in this Class may also only register in Classes 7, 8, 27, 32 and 37.** *Prize Sponsor: Highland County SPCA.*
11. **Gaited All Day: English Style** – Walk and pleasure gait.
12. **Junior Rider** – All tack – Ages 12 and under. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.
13. **Speed Barrel** – Single barrel. All tack. Horses must enter and exit ring at a walk.
14. **Junior Speed Barrel** – Ages 14 and under. All tack. Horses must enter and exit ring at a walk.
15. **Cloverleaf Barrels** - Open. All tack. Horses must enter and exit ring at a walk. *Special Prize: Belt Buckle*

20. ***Open Western Pleasure*** – Walk, jog, and lope. **Bonus Class! Double Payback!**
21. **4-H, FFA, or Pony Club All Day** – All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.

Entrants in this Class may also only register in Classes 7, 8, 10, 32 and 37.
28. **Young People's Horsemanship (English)** – Ages 18 and under. Walk, trot, and canter.

29. **Trail Racking Type** – All tack. Racking type gaited horse (no head nod). Walk and pleasure gait.
30. **Pole Bending** – All tack. Horses must enter and exit ring at a walk.
31. **Junior Pole Bending** – Ages 14 and under. All tack. Horses must enter and exit ring at a walk.
32. **Family Class** – All tack. Two or more members of one family. One entry, one ribbon, one money.
33. **Young People's Horsemanship (Western)** – Ages 18 and under. Walk, jog, and lope.
Rebel Trophy: Dorothy and Crysta Stephenson
34. **Ranch Horse Under Saddle** - Horse should move forward freely with a natural head position.
At Judge's discretion may include walk, trot, jog, lope and canter.
35. ***Keyhole*** – All tack. Horses must enter and exit ring at a walk. **Bonus Class! Double Payback!**
36. **Open Pair** – All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait. Two ribbons-one money.
37. **Costume Class** – Horses may be ridden or led, with or without a rider. *Sponsor: Lexi in Memory of Bailey*
38. **Open Trail Class** – All tack. Maximum 3 attempts per obstacle.

At your leisure from 2 pm – 4 pm behind grandstand.

Helmets: ASTM/SEI hard helmets are encouraged for all mounted riders and are mandatory in 4-H classes, beginner, ages 18 and under riders, hunter, and over fences classes. (Classes 1-6, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 21, 25, 27, 28, 31, 33)

Coggins: Copy of current (12) months negative Coggins test results must be left at registration.
Equine Activity Liability Waiver must be signed by all participants and/or guardians.

Assumption of Risk: All participants and spectators assume the inherent risk of injury associated with equine activities while on the fairgrounds.

Gaited horses are welcome in over fences classes. **Game classes** open to all types of horses and tack.

Open Accounts: A signed check must be left at registration.

Shows and Entertainment: Horse Show Flyer

Age: Based upon rider's age on day of show.

Fences classes: All equines permitted. ASTM/SEI hard helmets required.

Knock Down and Out: Single Fence. Knock down or refusal results in elimination. After each round, the fence will be raised. Equines and/or riders may only enter once. Highest clear jump wins. Starting height 2'6". Tie broken by jump off. Prize \$100 – winner takes all.

Highland County Residents Only Class is limited to those individuals who live in Highland County.

Judge: Classes may be split at the judge's discretion. The judge's decision is final. If there are more than 15 riders in a canter class, only half (½) of the class will canter at one time.

Horse Show Committee/Jump Course Manager: The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to combine or cancel any/all classes. The Jump Course Manager will set all courses, distances, and placement of fences.

Equines, exhibitors, and/or visitors engaged in inappropriate behavior as determined by the Horse Show Committee will be excused from the ring and fairgrounds. **Exhibitors** are responsible for only entering classes suited to themselves and their mounts. Horses are not permitted on the carnival grounds.

No alcohol is permitted on the fairgrounds property.

Dogs must be on leash and remain in the parking area.

Food will be available for purchase on the fairgrounds.

Directions:

From the South: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 220; fairgrounds located just north of Jerry's Electronics (429 Jackson River Road/US 220, Monterey, VA); entrance on the right (east) side of US 220, Jackson River Road.

From the East: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 250; turn left (south) onto US 220, Jackson River Road, and proceed .4 miles; fairgrounds entrance on the left (east) side of US 220, Jackson River Road.

From the West: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 250; turn right (south) onto US 220, and proceed .4 miles; fairgrounds entrance on the left (east) side of US 220, Jackson River Road.

From the North: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 220; proceed south on US 220, Jackson River Road, .4 miles south of the intersection of US Routes 220 and 250; fairgrounds entrance on the left (east) side of US 220, Jackson River Road.

All entries shall conform to the Federal Horse Protection Act.
