## **Grand Champion Trophy Rules:**

- To qualify the horse/rider combination must show in all the classes within the division except Jumpers
- Horses may be shown in the same class more than once, but the horse/rider combination can only be shown once
- Horses may be shown in multiple levels ranging from intro all the way up
- The horse/rider combination with the most points based on the placings earned in each of the divisions will win.
- Points based on placings are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place=6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place=5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place=4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place=3 points, 5<sup>th</sup> place=2 points and 6<sup>th</sup> place=1 point.
