

Overdrive, RBDigital Combine and What About Zinio?


In September, RBDigital merged into Overdrive. For our RBDigital users, that means that you will need to download app to continue listening to downloadable audiobooks, but now you'll have many more options! If you already have the Overdrive app, that will work, too!

All you need is your Wilson Public Library card and the pin number (call us at 784-2019 for that info!). Libby and Overdrive are available 24/7/365 with a WIFI connection and your books are available offline once downloaded. There are never fines. Never be caught without a book again!

Currently, there are over 150 magazines available for immediate download via RBDigital (formerly known as Zinio), our downloadable magazine stash. Again, this will change with Overdrive's acquisition, but we'll keep you up to date on Facebook and our website. Wilson Public Library Extending Hours Starting October 1, 2020

RESTRICTIONS AS OF OCTOBER 1 (New or updated restrictions are boldfaced and italicized)

Appointments for 30 minute public computer use are still required and can only be obtained by calling the library at 784-2019. Masks will be required for all public computer users as there could be multiple computer users in the room at the same

- If you have been sick or running a fever in the past two weeks, we ask that you please choose to not use the library until you
- Vulnerable patrons are invited to come for their visit between 10:00-11:00am.
- The library will provide hand sanitizer and ask all patrons entering the library to check in with a staff member and use hand sanitizer prior to entering the main area. If you have an aversion to hand sanitizer, we ask that you use soap and water in our bathrooms to wash your hands or choose to use the library at another time. This is for the safety of all citizens to limit contamination of library materials by the virus.
- Please practice social distancing while in the library.
- Wearing a mask is highly encouraged for patrons but required for patrons with a public computer appointment. All staff will wear masks or shields and potentially gloves.
- Patrons needing public computer access must call us at 784-2019 for an appointment for that day before entering the library. Appointments are required for those who need public computer access, are limited per day and are for 30 minutes. If a computer user agreement form is not on file, patrons must fill that out first within their 30 minute timeslot. Headphones are not available at this time. Masks are required for those using the computer lab.
- Wifi is available without an appointment; wifi can be used outside of the computer lab for up to an hour.
- ullet We welcome guests 8 and older; adults with children under 8 must use the library together. We ask that visits for library use other than public computers are limited to once per day, FOR UP TO ONE HOUR.
- In-person indoor programming will slowly be added back to the library but may require registration.
- Public Restrooms and Public Phones are only sanitized once per day; use at own risk. (see back page for more information)


