RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLES ON STREETS AND ROADS WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS

BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, CALHOUN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION I: THAT the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the VILLAGE OF HAMBURG having determined that public safety will not be jeopardized, hereby authorizes the operation of non-highway vehicles on roadways and streets under the jurisdiction of the Village of Hamburg. The Village having considered the volume, speed, and character of traffic on said roadways, has determined that the non-highway vehicles may safely travel on or across the Village roadways. All non-highway vehicles must comply with Illinois Statute 625 ILCS 5/11-1426.1 which states at a minimum said vehicles must contain the following:

Brakes, a steering apparatuses, tires, a rear view mirror, red reflector warning devices in the front and rear, a slow moving emblem (as required of other vehicles in Section 12-709 of this Code) on the rear on the non-highway vehicle, a headlight that emits a white light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the front, a tail lamp which emits a red light visible from a distance of at least 100 feet from the rear, brake lights, and a turn signal.

All non-highway vehicles when being operated on a roadway shall be required to have its headlight and tail lamps lighted as required by Section 12-201 of Illinois Vehicle Code.

Any person who operates a non-highway vehicle on a street, highway, or a roadway shall be subject to the mandatory insurance require under Article 6 of Chapter 7 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

SECTION II: THAT the VILLAGE CLERK shall cause a copy of this RESOLUTION be mailed to each media that may request it.

SECTION III: THAT the VILLAGE CLERK shall cause a copy of this RESOLUTION be placed on the Bulletin Board in the Village Hall, Hamburg, Illinois.

SECTION IV: ALL resolutions and parts of resolution in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
