The PON was bred to herd sheep and the herding genes are as strong as ever, they do need a job and must have a project to do each day.

Whether you eventually purchase a PON from us or from another breeder, you owe it to yourself and the breed to research the background on your future puppy. Do not be afraid to ask about the health of the sire and dam of the puppy. Do not be afraid to ask to see health certifications such as OFA clearances (dysplasia) or annual CERF eye exams.

Know the facts before you purchase a pet that will be a part of your family for 10 to 15 years.
