Individual Week Breakdown/Details

Color Guard Technique Camp: Our 7th annual Technique Camp is free! It will help novice members learn aspects of modern dance combined with flag/prop technique. Those who are more experienced will continue to refine their fundamental skills in these areas <u>and</u> work on Rifle and Sabre Techniques. (**Postponed**)

Full Field Show Camp: All wind, percussion and color guard members are <u>required</u> to attend this camp in preparation for the fall field show season. The time on the field and time with the entire field show staff is limited; therefore, this is a very crucial week to learn marching techniques, learn how to read coordinate sheets, learn the actual field show routine and work on ensemble concepts all broken down. In addition to the preparation aspects, we work on team building and getting to know each other.

What to Bring to our Tahoma Technique & Field Show Clinics:

- Comfortable athletic shoes-these should fit the student's feet and be tied. We will be working on increasing our lung efficiency. The music and show will move fast and we have to be ready for it! <u>Do not bring anything with heels, any type of</u> <u>sandals, or flip flops. If you do, you will be running and marching in bare feet.</u>
- 2. **Sunscreen**-Hopefully the weather will be nice for us as we are going to be outside quite a bit-meaning lots and lots!
- 3. A sack lunch or money for lunch The students will have 30 minutes of social time to have lunch and hang out with their friends. They may go off campus for lunch if they choose, but should remain with a group and need to be ready to start **ON TIME**.
- 4. **Breakfast -** Make sure your student has had a good breakfast before he/she arrives. We want everyone to be at their best to learn and to perform.
- 5. WATER or sports drink-There will be breaks over the course of the day for the students to run to the bathroom and get drinks of water, but it will be most efficient for them to bring a <u>water bottle with their name on it each day</u>. They may have this with them both outside and in the rehearsal rooms. THE LARGER THE WATER BOTTLE THE BETTER (1 LITER WORKS THE BEST)
- 6. **1-inch binder of your choice-**Please bring a 1-inch binder to put all of your field show drill charts (pictures) and music in for camp. I strongly recommend page protectors in the event that it happens to rain on us during the season. Please make sure that you bring some colored writing utensils and have your name permanently and clearly marked. We will be using these every day...you will be charged for replacement drill chart packets.
- 7. A Deck of Playing Cards-Please bring a deck of playing cards. Bring the most unique deck that you have...it does not matter what they are as long as they remain appropriate! We will use them as field place holders/markers as we are learning our sets on the field! *Most interested in the design on the back side for you to identify your own deck!*
