Act of Faith Prayer

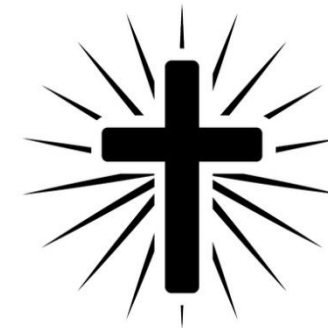
O my God, I firmly believe that you are one God
