## Town Clerk Report

The Towns total revenue for the month of April 2018 was \$340.00, \$290.00 for dogs, \$50 for registrar. We had 2 new dog licenses and 24 dog renewals. We disbursed: \$155.00 to Wyoming County, \$38.00 to Ag & Market for dogs. To the general fund, Supervisor May; \$147.00, \$77.00 from Dogs, \$20.00 for late fees, \$50.00 for registrar fees

Each member of the Board has received a DRAFT copy of a local law entitled "Regulating Solar Energy Systems" for review, the Planning Board is working on this process.
