

Meeting Minutes

July 10, 2016

The Trapshooting Hall of Fame museum building at the World Shooting Complex will have its grand opening at this year's Grand American. The World Shooting Complex is again open for business. ATA officials have negotiated a side agreement to its lease that will allow the ATA to take over operation of the facility during the shooting season if the state of Illinois were to close the facility again. The ATA website now provides clubs with the ability to send programs and list results. This year the Eastern Zone will be electing a new vice-president.

State Team members for 2016 were recognized and pins awarded.

Steve Szczechura spoke about trying to move the shoot date so as not to conflict with the NY State Shoot. Options for consideration should be Memorial Day weekend, early August and July 4th weekend.

Ron Sevigny rose to commend Dean Adams for his service to the NHCTA. Dean will be moving to South Carolina next year.
